GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

OF Price \$1.00 a year

A decline in the output of wheat flour was registered by Canadian mills for the month of January 1953, with 1,771,766 barrels produced in comparison with 1,835,957 barrels produced in the same month last year. In spite of this drop in production, the total production of wheat flour for the first half of the current crop year (August to January) amounted to 12,156,297 barrels, well in advance of the total of 10,969,292 barrels in the same period of 1951-52.

Flour mill operations for January 1953 averaged 70.1 per cent when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 97,195 barrels. Mills reporting in December operated 73.0 per cent of their combined rate capacity for the same number of days.

Wheat used for the manufacture of flour in January 1953 amounted to 7,887,271 bushels compared with 8,466,322 bushels for the corresponding month last year. Total wheat milled for flour for the first six months of the current crop year amounted to 54,614,067 bushels, while for the same period in 1951-52 the amount was 50,274,937 bushels.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of January 1953 amounted to 3,115,700 bushels for flour and 156,146 bushels of feed

wheat.

Production of Ontario winter wheat flour for the month of January 1953 continued firm with 96,198 barrels against 88,470 barrels for the same month last year. The total of this grade of flour for the August—January period of the current crop year was 613,385 barrels compared with the total of 589,730 barrels for the same six months in 1951-52.

Wheat flour exports in January 1953, according to the publication "Trade of Canada" amounted to 826,274 barrels, bringing the August—January total to 6,458,584 barrels shipped to other countries. Customs exports (adjusted to remove time lag) for the comparable period in 1951-52 amounted to 4,601,386 barrels.

Milifeed production for January 1953 fell below the previous monthly outputs of the current crop year, with 59,265 tons registered against 67,788 tons for the same month a year ago. The breakdown was bran 25,719 (28,566) tons, shorts 23,316 (27,372) tons and middlings 10,230 (11,850) tons. Total millfeed production for the first six months of the current crop year amounted to 418,434 tons compared with 404,758 tons for the same six months in 1951-52.

Total ground feeds for January 1953 amounted to 132,213,646 pounds, while for the same month last year the amount was 173,866,841 pounds. The items in the group were as follows with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 12,065,160 (20,082,080); Ground Oats 30,486,568 (36,512,461); Gracked Corn 6,181,202 (6,560,019); Ground Barley 15,692,356 (22,786,154); and Mixed Grain 67,788,360 (87,926,127).


