Wheat flour production in Canadian mills for the month of November 1953, amounted to 1,866,563 barrels compared with 2,175,933 barrels for the same month last year. Production for the first four months of the current crop year was 6,942,373 barrels while for the same period last year the amount was 8,550,851 barrels.

Mill operations for November 1953 averaged 77.2 per cent when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 96,669 barrels. Mills reporting in October operated at 75.7 per cent of their combined rated capacity when computed on a 26-day working period.

Wheat milled for flour in November amounted to 8,216,541 bushels compared with 9,827,918 for the same month last year. Ontario winter wheat included in the total for the month was 799,075 bushels against 451,412 bushels for November 1952.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of November 1953 amounted to 3,256,596 bushels for flour and 121,293 bushels of feed wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour production for the month of November 1953 amounted to 173,005 barrels compared with 98,631 barrels manufactured for the same month last year. Production of this grade of flour for the August—November period of the current crop year totalled 811,335 barrels while for the same period in 1952-53 the total was 425,552 barrels.

Wheat flour exports in November 1953 according to the Trade of Canada amounted to 900,514 barrels making an August-November total of 8,224,941 barrels shipped to other countries. Customs exports (adjusted to remove time lag) for the comparable period last year were 4,454,148 barrels.

Millfeed production for November 1953 amounted to 60,369 tons compared with 76,469 tons for the same month last year. This was comprised of bran 25,775 (31,552) tons, shorts 26,117 (31,075) tons and middlings 8,477 (13,842) tons. Total millfeed production for the first four months of the present crop year ending with November amounted to 226,900 tons against a total of 297,967 tons for the same four months of 1952-53.

Ground feeds for November totalled 142,920,656 pounds compared with 150,283,242 pounds for the corresponding month last year. The items in this group were as follows with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 13,527,780 (17,657,340); Ground Oats 33,640,038 (33,398,414); Cracked Corn 6,419,868 (5,965,976); Ground Barley 18,018,007 (16,519,447); and Mixed Grain 71,314,963 (76,742,065).
