#### GHAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Canadian flour mills reporting for the month of December 1953 had an output of 1,815,315 barrels of wheat flour, down slightly from the November output of 1,866,563 barrels, as well as the comparative December 1952 output of 1,831,673 barrels. Total production for the August—December period of the current crop year assounted to 8,757,648 barrels, a drop of 1.6 million barrels from the production of 10,382,524 barrels for the same period in 1952-53. Preliminary wheat flour total for the calendar year ending with December 1953 amounted to about 22.2 million barrels compared with 24.1 million barrels for the previous calendar year.

Mill operations for December 1953 average 72.7 per cent when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 96,094 barrels. Mills reporting for November operated 77.2 per cent of their combined rated capacity when computed on a 25-day working period.

Wheat used for the manufacture of flour in December 1953 amounted to 8,018,819 bushels compared with 8,143,140 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. This brought the August-December total of wheat used in the current crop year to 38,894,403 bushels against 46,710,908 bushels for the same period in the crop year 1952-53. The preliminary total of wheat milled for flour for the calendar year ending December 1953 amounted to about 98.8 million bushels compared with about 109.4 million bushels for the calendar year 1952.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of December 1953 amounted to 3,052,177 bushels for flour and 120,552 bushels of feed wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour for the month of December 1953 had the lowest single output so far this crop year, with 133,929 barrels reported against 91,195 barrels for the same month a year ago. In spite of this December decline in volume, production for the first five months of the current crop year (August—December) totalled 945,264 barrels, well above the comparable total of 516,747 barrels for this grade of flour in the same period in 1952-53.

According to the publication "Trade of Canada" wheat flour exports for December 1953 amounted to 911,726 barrels, bringing the total exports for the first five months of this crop season to 4,136,667 barrels compared with 5,597,614 barrels (adjusted to remove time lag) for the same five months a year ago.

Millfeed production for December 1953 amounted to 58,418 tons compared with 61,160 tons for the same month last year. The breakdown was bran 25,309 (25,189) tons, shorts 24,660 (25,235) tons and middlings 8,449 (10,736) tons. Total millfeed production for the August—December period of 1953-54 was 285,318 tons while for the comparable period last crop year the total was 359,127 tons.

Ground feeds for December 1953 totalled 145,951,988 pounds compared with 147,225,180 pounds for December of the previous year.

The items in this group were as follows with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 14,170,080 (15,822,840); Ground Oats 32,579,079 (32,752,618); Gracked Corn 7,897,552 (6,332,209); Ground Barley 17,600,660 (17,000,936) and Mixed Grain 73,704,617 (75,316,577).


