GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The improved activity which was evident in Canadian flour mills for February continued throughout the month of March and an output of 1,972,109 barrels was recorded for the month of March 1953 as compared with 1,939,359 barrels for March last year. Total production for the eight months covered for the August—March period of the current crop year amounted to 15,925,782 barrels against 14,708,509 barrels for the corresponding period in 1951-52.

Flour mill operations for March 1953 averaged 77.5 per cent when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 97,835 barrels. Mills reporting in February operated 77.4 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 24 days.

Wheat used for flour in March 1953 amounted to 8,802,652 bushels, while for the same month last year the amount was 8,866,368 bushels. The quantity of wheat used for flour for the August--March period of the current crop year totalled 71,368,373 bushels compared with 67,461,488 bushels for the same period last crop year.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of March 1953 amounted to 2,556,277 bushels for flour and 140,685 bushels of

feed wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour production for March 1953 was recorded at 99,540 barrels, considerably more than the figure of 69,923 barrels in March last year. Production for this grade of flour for the eight months under review for the August-March period of the present crop year totalled 795,414 barrels against 731,068 barrels for the same period in 1951-52.

According to the publication "Trade of Canada", wheat flour exports in March 1953 amounted to 956,282 barrels, making a total of 8,074,592 barrels shipped for the August--March period of 1952-53. Customs exports (adjusted to remove time lag) for the comparable period in 1951-52 amounted to 6,719,846 barrels.

Millfeed production for March 1953 amounted to 66,693 tons compared with 70,219 tons for the same month a year ago. The breakdown was bran 31,110 (30,837) tons, shorts 24,020 (28,621) tons and middlings 11,563 (10,761) tons. Total millfeed production for eight months ending with March 1953 amounted to 545,076 tons while for the same period a year ago the amount was 540,584 tons.

Ground feeds for March 1953 amounted to 138,564,253 pounds compared with 163,669,957 pounds for the same month last year. The items in this total were as follows with the comparable figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 14,742,300 (19,224,620); Ground Oats 35,196,397 (34,964,410); Cracked Corn 6,773,605 (6,234,528); Ground Barley 17,080,327 (20,472,805); and Mixed Grain 64,771,624 (82,773,594).
