GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Wheat flour production as reported by Canadian flour mills for August, the opening month of the 1953-54 season, dropped in volume to 1,423,693 barrels. This was the lowest monthly output since July 1951, when 1.4 million barrels were recorded. The comparable August output for last year was 1.9 million barrels and the ten-year average production for August, based on the years 1943 to 1952, amounted to 1.9 million barrels.

Mill operations for August averaged 56.2 per cent when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 97,500 barrels. Mills reporting in July operated 74.4 per cent of their combined rated capacity for the same number of days.

Wheat used for the manufacture of flour for August 1953 amounted to 6,345,959 bushels, while for the same month last year the amount was 8,803,009 bushels. Ontario winter wheat included in this year's total amounted to 900,341 bushels against 443,579 bushels for August 1952.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of August 1953 amounted to 3,584,646 bushels for flour and 128,096 bushels of feed

wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour production for August 1953 amounted to 193,392 barrels compared with 100,954 barrels for the same month last year. Historical survey figures for this grade of flour show the monthly output of 193,392 barrels for this August exceeded only twice in the last thirty years. In August and September 1948 Ontario winter wheat flour production amounted to 233,956 and 249,198 barrels, respectively.

According to the publication "Trade of Canada", wheat flour exports for the month of August 1953 amounted to 827,588 barrels. The comparable figure for the same month last year was 895,775 barrels when adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns.

Millfeed production for August 1953 amounted to 47,180 tons compared with 68,857 tons for the corresponding month last year. This was comprised of bran 18,001 (26,280) tons, shorts 22,283 (28,887) tons and middlines 6,896 (13,690) tons.

Ground feeds for August 1953 totalled 115,796,768 pounds, while a year ago the total for the same month was 136,220,854 pounds. The items in this group were as follows with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 12,737,280 (16,935,180); Ground Oats 32,250,786 (32,853,243); Gracked Corn 7,035,164 (5,561,190); Ground Barley 15,122,982 (23,204,614); and Mixed Grain 48,650,556 (57,666,627).
