GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Price \$1.00 a year The low flour production of Canadian mills at the commencement of the present crop year, though partially offset by increased activity in the second month of this season, was still lagging behind the comparable period of 1952-53 when September returns were recorded. Reported production for September 1953 amounted to 1,742,629 barrels compared with 2,132,496 barrels for the same month last year. The total output for the first two months of 1953-54 was 3,166,322 barrels, while for the same period a year ago the output was 4,04,473 barrels.

Nill operations for September 1953 averaged 71.6 per cent when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 97,360 barrels. Mills reporting in August operated 56.2 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days.

Wheat used for the manufacture of flour for September 1953 amounted to 7,692,345 bushels, and included 1,045,390 bushels of Ontario winter wheat. In September of last year the total wheat milled was 9,608,024 bushels with 528,396 bushels of the Ontario winter grade included.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of September 1953 amounted to 3,211,119 bushels for flour and 114,398 bushels of feed wheat.

The crop year 1953-54 opened with two substantial monthly outputs of Ontario winter wheat flour recorded from the returns of mills operating in this particular grade. The amount for August was 193,392 barrels, while September had an output of 226,127 barrels. This brought the total for the two months under review to 419,519 barrels against 217,778 barrels for the same two months of the previous crop year.

According to the publication "Trade of Canada", wheat flour exports for the month of September 1953 amounted to 747,741 barrels, bringing the total exports for the first two months of this milling season to 1,575,329 barrels compared with 1,982,763 barrels (adjusted to remove time lag) for the comparable months of 1952-53.

Millfeed production for September 1953, amounted to 57,127 tons compared with 75,207 tons for the same month a year ago. The breakdown was bran 22,664 (28,124) tons, morts 25,832 (33,079) tons and middlings 8,631 (14,004) tons. Total millfeed production for the first two months of 1953-54 amounted to 104,307 tons compared with 144,064 tons for the same two months of the previous crop year.

Ground feeds for September 1953 totalled 127,440,956 pounds compared with 143,983,942 pounds in September last year. The items in this group were as follows with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 14,346,300 (17,141,880); Ground Oats 34,777,945 (33,303,174): Cracked Corn 6,375,111 (6,116,497); Ground Barley 16,559,240 (20,157,827); and Mixed Grain 55,382,360 (67,264,564).
