GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Wheat flour production as recorded from Canadian milling returns for July 1954 amounted to 1,595,813 barrels, the second lowest monthly output in the twelve months ending with July. The volume of production for the crop year 1953-54 totalled 20,803,772 barrels, down more than three million barrels from the recorded total of 23,865,625 barrels for the previous crop year. The 1953-54 fleur production was the lowest since 1949-50.

Mills reporting operations in July 1954 averaged 63,4 per cent of their combined rated capacity of 96,889 barrels for a 26-day working period. Mills reporting in June operated 70,4 per cent of their combined rated capacity for the same number of days. The weighted average of working capacity for the crop year 1953-54 was 70.1 per cent compared with 81.4 per cent for the previous crop year.

Wheat milled for flour for July 1954 amounted to 7,008,971 bushels compared with 8,328,311 bushels for the corresponding month last year. This brought the total wheat milled for flour for the crop year ending with July to 91,868,038 bushels against 106,727,237 bushels for the crop year 1952-53. Ontario winter wheat milled for the crop year under survey and included in the above yearly total was 7,796,349 bushels compared with 5,241,333 bushels of Ontario winter wheat milled for the crop year 1952-53.

Stocks of wheat in mill bine at the close of July 1954 amounted to 2,547,520 bushels for flour and 126,006 bushels of feed wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour output for July 1954 amounted to 89,970 barrels compared with 101,065 barrels for the same month last year. The total 1953-54 crop year production for this grade of flour reached an all-time high of 1,707,163 barrels compared with a total of 1,161,210 barrels of the same grade for the previous crop year.

According to the publication "Trade of Canada", wheat flour exports for the month of July 1954 amounted to 864,694 barrels, bringing the total shipments for the crop year 1953-54 to 10,291,561 barrels, a decline of almost 2.3 million barrels from last year's comparable total of 12,555,714 barrels (adjusted to remove time lag).

Millfed production for July 1954 amounted to 51,851 tons compared with 61,904 tons for the same month last year. The breakdown for the month was bran 21,054 (24,467) tons, shorts 24,261 (27,351) tons and middlings 6,536 (10,086) tons. The total millfed production of 677,702 tons for 1953-54 was down in volume from the total production of 810,480 tons recorded for the previous crop year.

Ground feeds for July 1954 amounted to 132,095,858 pounds compared with 113,999,711 pounds for the same month last year. The items in this total were as follows with the comparable figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 14,949,120 (14,222,460); Ground Oats 35,403,430 (34,495,763); Cracked Corn 7,388,696 (6,463,959); Ground Barley 24,249,925 (15,041,880); and Mixed Grain 50,104,687 (43,775,649).




