### GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Canadian wheat flour production for September 1954 was recorded at 1,929,031 barrels compared with 1,739,366 barrels for the same month a year ago. The September production was up from the August production of 1,812,296 barrels, but fell below the ten-year (1944-45 to 1953-54) September average production of 2,035,097 barrels. Total output of flour for the first two months of the current crop year amounted to 3,741,327 barrels compared with 3,162,928 barrels for the same period in 1953-54.

Mills reporting operations in September 1954 average 79.4 per cent of their combined rated daily capacity of 97.49 barrels for a 25-day working period. Mills reporting in August operated 72.0 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days.

Wheat milled for flour in September 1954 amounted to 8,581,211 bushels, while for the same month last year the amount was 7,677,653 bushels. Ontario winter wheat included in the September total amounted to 571,290 bushels against 1,045,390 bushels for September 1953. Total wheat used for the two months under survey for the current crop year was 16,640,984 bushels compared with 14,022,667 bushels for the same period in 1953-54.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of September 1954 amounted to 3,638,525 bushels for flour and 169,396 bushels of feed wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour production for September 1954 amounting to 123,677 barrels was down in volume from the same month of the previous year when 226,127 barrels were recorded. This brought the total for the two months under review in 1954-55 to 271,658 barrels compared with 419,519 barrels for the same period last crop year.

According to the publication "Trade of Canada", wheat flour exports for the month of September 1954 amounted to 795,388 barrels, bringing the total exports for the first two months of this milling season to 1,546,514 barrels compared with 1,700,603 barrels (adjusted to remove time lag) for the comparable months of 1953-54.

Millfeed production for September 1954 amounted to 63,877 tons compared with 57,011 tons for the same month a year ago. This was comprised of bran 26,456 (22,618) tons, shorts 27,266 (25,762) tons and middlings 10,155 (8,631) tons. Total millfeed production for the first two months of the current crop year amounted to 123,649 tons, while for the same two months in 1953-54 the total was 104,180 tons.

Ground feeds for September 1954 totalled 133,066,113 pounds compared with 128,223,471 pounds in September last year. The items in this group were as follows with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 14,429,940 (14,285,580); Ground Oats 30,287,288 (34,151,563); Cracked Corn 6,489,350 (6,888,967); Ground Barley 18,950,781 (15,826,712); and Mixed Grain 62,908,754 (57,070,649).
