GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

CRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Wheat flour production from Canadian mills was set at 1,589,273 barrels for the month of February 1955 against 1,714,357 barrels for the same month last year. Production for the August—February period of the current crop year totalled 12,378,680 barrels, which was above the total of 12,138,109 barrels for the comparative period of the crop year 1953-54.

Mill operations for February 1955 average 68.3 per cent when computed on a 24-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 96,889 barrels. Mills reporting for January operated 64.6 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 25 days.

Wheat used for the manufacture of flour in February 1955 amounted to 7,113,437 bushels compared with 7,552,537 bushels used in the corresponding month a year ago. For the August—February period of the current crop year a total of 55,031,932 bushels of wheat was manufactured into flour compared with 53,616,362 bushels in the same period in 1953-54.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of February 1955 amounted to 3,732,865 bushels for flour and 155,586 bushels of feed wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour production recorded at 87,816 barrels for the month of February 1955 was down in volume from the previous month's output of 98,764 barrels, as well as the output of 113,831 barrels for February last year. The total production for this grade of flour for the August—February period of the current crop year smounted to 818,241 barrels, while for the corresponding period in 1953-54 the total production was 1,165,493 barrels.

According to the publication "Trade of Canada", wheat flour exports for February 1955 amounted to 600,104 barrels, bringing the total shipments for the August-February period of the crop year 1954-55 to 5,144,530 barrels compared with total shipments of 5,869,397 barrels (adjusted to remove time lag) for the same period a year ago.

Millfeed production for February 1955 amounted to 54,224 tons compared with 55,887 tons for the same month last year. This was made up of bran 23,901 (25,972) tons, shorts 21,756 (22,456) tons, and middlings 8,567 (7,459) tons. Total millfeed production for the August—February period of the current crop year amounted to 410,973 tons compared with 396,410 tons for the same period in the crop year 1953-54.

Ground feeds for February 1955 totalled 138,511,739 pounds compared with 138,578,685 pounds for the same month last year. The items in this group were as follows with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 14,034,420 (13,508,760); Ground Outs 28,710,352 (34,302,287); Cracked Corn 5,876,193 (6,644,530); Ground Barley 18,509,157 (19,153,043); and Mixed Grain 71,381,617 (64,970,065).


