GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Falling a few thousand berrels short of the previous month's production, the month of June closed with an output of wheat flour amounting to 1,039,457 barrels, bringing the total production for the eleven months ending with June 1955 to 19,287,445 barrels. Although June production for last year was higher with 1,708,977 barrels recorded, the eleven months' total for the current crop year continued to show a slight lead over the total of 19,205,662 barrels for the same eleven months in 1953-54.

Flour mill operations for June 1955 averaged 68.5 per cent when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 92,009 barrels. Mills reporting in May operated 73.3 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 25 days.

Wheat used in the production of flour for June 1955 encounted to 7,354,785 bushels against 7,807,008 bushels for the same month last year. The total wheat used for the eleven months under review to the and of June 1955 was 85,989,969 bushels, while for the corresponding period in 1953-54 the total wheat used was 84,849,066 bushels.

Stocks of wheet in mill bins at the close of June 1955 amounted to 2,367,583 bushels for flour and 121,492 bushels of feed wheat,

Ontario winter wheat flour production for June 1955 amounted to 119,215 barrels compared with 104,997 barrels for the same month last year. Total production of this grade of flour for the eleven months of the current crop year ending with June 1955 amounted to 1,241,851 barrels, compared with 1,617,193 barrels for the same eleven months in 1953-54.

According to the publication "Trade of Canada", wheat flour exports in June 1955 amounted to 849,848 barrels. Total shipments for the August-June period of the current crop year totalled 8,517,116 barrels, approximately 1.0 million barrels short of the total of 9,522.841 barrels (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag) shipped in the same period in 1953-54.

Millfeed production for June 1955 amounted to 56,187 tons compared with 57,325 tons in June a year ago. The breakdown was bran 22,673 (22,966) tons, shorts 23,912 (27,138) tons and middlings 9,602 (7,221) tons. Total millfeed production for the August-June period of the current crop year was 646,218 tons, with a comparative total of 626,643 tons for the corresponding period in 1953-54.

Ground feeds for June 1955 totalled 119,587,861 pounde compared with 127,344,132 pounds for the same month last year. The items in the total were as follows with the comparable figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 18,183,780 (13,878,960); Ground Oats 26,492,207 (33,146,735); Cracked Corn 7,589,832 (8,538,891); Ground Barley 16,507,665 (21,835,277); and Mixed Grain 50,814,377 (49,944,269).
