

Wheat flour production in Canadian mills dropped to a low of 1,425,089 barrels for the month of July 1955, thus ending the crop year 1954-55 with a total flour output of 20,713,534 barrels, or some 87,000 barrels short of the total of 20,800,974 barrels for the previous crop year. The output for the month of July last year amounted to 1,595,312 barrels.

Flour mill operations for July 1955 averaged 62.7 per cent when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 90,964 barrels. Mills reporting in June operated 68.5 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days. The weighted average of working capacity for the crop year 1954-55 was 71.7 per cent against 70.1 per cent for the previous crop year.

Enest milled for flour for July 1955 amounted to b,418,292 bushels compared with 7,006,203 bushels for the corresponding month last year. Total wheat milled for flour for the crop year ending with July 1955 amounted to 92,408,261 bushels, while for the crop year 1953-54 the wheat milled was 91,855,269 bushels. Onterio winter wheat milled for the current crop year and included in the ebowe yearly total was 6,012,590 bushels compared with 7,796,349 bushels of Ontario winter wheat milled in the crop year 1953-54.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of July 1955 amounted to 2,973,986 bushels for flour and 119,150 bushels of feed

Onterio winter wheat flour production for July 1955 amounted to 84,195 barrels compared with 89,970 barrels for the same month a year ego. The total 1954-55 orop year production for this grade of flour, recorded at 1,326,046 barrels, was down in volume from the previous crop year's high of 1,707,163 barrels but held second place in volume according to statistical tables maintained for earlier years.

According to the publication "Trade of Canada", mheat flour exports in July 1955 amounted to 485,662 barrels, bringing the total shipments for the crop year 1954-55 to 9,002,778 barrels, a decline of almost 1.3 million barrels from last year's comparable total of 10,276,951 barrels (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag).

Millfeed production for July 1955 amounted to 49,756 tons compared with 51,813 tons for the same month last year. This was comprised of bran 20,037 (21,044) tons, shorts 21,566 (24,229) tons and middlings 8,153 (6,540) tons. The total millfeed production of 695,974 tons for 1954-55 was slightly above the production of 678,456 tons recorded for the pravious crop year.

Ground feeds for July 1955 amounted to 116,569,565 pounds compared with 124,661,492 pounds for the same month last year. The items in this total were as follows with the compareble figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 17,043,900 (14,231,160); Ground Osts 27,392,076 (31,969,158); Gracked Corn 8,221,723 (7,734,328); Ground Barley 17,654,981 (21,598,981); and Mixed Grain 46,256,885 (49,127,865).
