GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Wheat flour mills in Ceneda reporting for July 1956, the final month of the crop year 1955-56, had a flour output of 3,497,943 hundredweight, as compared with 2,795,048 hundredweight for the corresponding month of the previous crop year. The volume for July 1956 was 25 per cent above the same month last year and about four per cent above the ten-year (1946-55) July average production recorded at 3,364,926 hundredweight. The total flour output for the crop year ending with July 1956 and amounting to 40,158,888 hundredweight was below the previous crop year total of 40,606,599 hundredweight and was the lowest crop year total since 1949-50 which closed with an output of 39,708,032 hundredweight.

Mill operations for July 1956 averaged 79.8 per cent when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 175,283 bundredweight. Mills reporting in June operated 72.4 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days. The weighted average of working capacity for the crop year 1955-56 was 73.7 per cent compared with 71.7 per cent for the previous crop year.

Wheat milled for flour for July 1956 amounted to 7,941,219 bushels against 6,418,694 bushels for the same month a year ago. This brought the total wheat milled for flour for the crop year 1955-56 to 91,794,533 bushels compared with 92,406,768 bushels for the previous crop year. Ontario winter wheat milled for the crop year under survey and included in the above yearly total was 5,390,023 bushels compared with 6,015,804 bushels of Ontario winter wheat milled for the crop year 1954-55.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of July 1956 amounted to 2,124,227 bushels for flour and 148,766 bushels of feed wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour production for July 1956 amounted to 148,152 hundredweight compared with 163,654 hundredweight for the same month last year. The total 1955-56 crop year production for this grade of flour amounted to 2,331,959 hundredweight compared with 2,599,083 hundredweight in 1954-55.

According to the publication "Trade of Cenada", wheat flour exports in July 1956 amounted to 1,580,750 hundredweight, bringing the total shipments for the crop year 1955-56 to 16,898,583 hundredweight, down in wolume from last crop year's comparable total of 17,692,945 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag).

Millfeed production for July 1956 amounted to 60,926 tons compared with 49,760 tons for the corresponding month last year. The breakdown was bran 24,262 (20,039) tons, shorts 25,118 (21,568) tons and middlings 11,546 (8,153) tons. The total millfeed production of 703,415 tons for 1955-56 was slightly above the production of 696,450 tons recorded for the previous crop year.

Ground feeds for July 1956 amounted to 121,447,236 pounds compared with 116,108,120 pounds for the same month last year. The items in the total were as follows with the comparable figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds. Feed Wheat 20,138,640 (16,211,280); Ground Oats 26,903,256 (26,769,706); Cracked Corn 10,168,342 (7,656,123); Ground Barley 18,096,660 (17,443,445); and Mixed Grain 46,140,338 (48,027,566).









WHEAT FLOUR PRODUCTION
