#### GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Wheat flour mills in Ganada, reporting for the month of October 1957 had an output of 3,688,000 hundredweight of wheat flour compared with 3,542,000 hundredweight for the corresponding month last year. The ten-year (1947-1956) October average production was 3,941,000 hundredweight. Production of wheat flour for the August-October period of the current crop year totalled 10,213,000 hundredweight against 10,185,000 hundredweight for the same period in 1956-57. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 267,000 hundredweight against 210,000 hundredweight in October 1956.

Mills reporting operations for October 1957 averaged 79.0 per cent of their combined rated capacity of 179,000 hundredweight for a 26 day working period. Mills reporting in September operated 78.5 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 24 days.

Wheat milled for flour in October 1957 amounted to 8,315,000 bushels compared with 8,041,000 bushels milled in October a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the October 1957 total amounted to 621,000 bushels compared with 452,000 bushels for the same month last year. Total wheat used for flour for the August-October period of the current crop year was 23,039,000 bushels compared with 23,148,000 bushels for the same period last crop year.

Stocks of wheat for flour in mill bins at the close of October 1957 amounted to 3,102,000 bushels.

According to the publication "Trade of Canada", exports of wheat flour for October 1957 amounted to 1,512,000 hundredweight, bringing the total exports for the first three months of this milling season to 3,780,000 hundredweight compared with 4,008,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) for the comparable months of 1956-57.

Millfeed production amounting to 62,000 tons in October 1957 compared with 61,000 tons in October last year, was comprised of bran 29,000 (26,000) tons, shorts 25,000 (26,000) tons and middlings 8,000 (10,000) tons. Total millfeeds for the first three months under review in the current crop year amounted to 173,000 tons compared with 177,000 tons for the same period last crop year.





## WHEAT FLOUR PRODUCTION
