### GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Canadian flour mills reporting for the month of November 1957 had a theat flours production of 3,638,000 hundredweight compared with 3,637,000 hundredweight for the same month in 1956 and 3,885,000 hundredweight for the ten-year (1947-1956) archage November output. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity recorded for the month under THE review amounted to 213,000 hundredweight against 207,000 hundredweight in November 1958.

Mill operations for November 1957 averaged 80.9 per cent when computed on a daily capacity of 180,000 hundredweight for a 25 day working period. Mills reporting in October operated 79.0 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days.

Wheat used for the manufacture of flour for November 1957 amounted to 8,186,000 bushels against 8,300,000 bushels for the same month in 1956. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 492,000 bushels compared with 453,000 bushels of this grade for November 1956. In the August-November period of the current crop year, 31,225,000 bushels of wheat went into the manufacture of flour while for the same period in 1956-57 the amount used was 31,448,000 bushels.

Stocks of wheat for flour in mill bins at the close of November 1957 amounted to 3,611,000 bushels.

According to the publication "Trade of Canada", wheat flour exports in November 1957 amounted to 1,248,000 hundredweight. Total shipments for the August-November period under review for the current crop year amounted to 5,028,000 hundredweight compared with 5,277,000 hundredweight shipped in the same period last crop year.

Millfeed production for November 1957 amounted to 61,000 tons, while for the same month in 1956, the amount was 63,000 tons. The breakdown was bran 28,000 (27,000) tons, shorts 25,000 (26,000) tons and middlings 8,000 (11,000) tons.


WHEAT FLOUR EXPORTS
