GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Wheat flour production for Canadian mills for the month of March 1957, reported at 2,982,776 hundredweight, was down alightly from the previous month's production of 2,992,154 hundredweight. Production for the comparable month last year amounted to 3,335,547 hundredweight, while the ten-year (1947-1956) average March production amounted to 3,803,292 hundredweight. Production of flour for the August-March period of the current crop year totalled 26,011,327 hundredweight against 26,690,281 hundredweight for the same period in the crop year 1955-56.

Mill operations in March 1957 averaged 63.9 per cent when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 179,503 hundredweight. Wills reporting for February operated 69.7 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 24 days.

Wheat used in the manufacture of flour in March 1957 amounted to 6,684,160 bushels, bringing the total for the August-March period of the current crop year to 58,927,963 bushels against 61,070,321 bushele for the same period in the crop year 1955-56. Ontario winter wheat included in March 1957 was 393,341 bushels compared with 426,607 bushels of this grade for the same month last year.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of March 1957 amounted to 2,679,258 bushels for flour and 113,399 bushels of feed wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour recorded at 165,777 hundredweight for March 1957 was down in volume from the same month of the previous year when the production was 175,133 hundredweight. Total production for this grade of flour for the August-March period of the current crop year amounted to 1,484,065 hundredweight compared with 1,610,891 hundredweight for the same period last crop year.

According to the publication "Trade of Canada", exports of wheat flour for March 1957 amounted to 1,207,110 hundredweight, bringing the total shipments for the August-March period of the current crop year to 10,693,382 hundredweight compared with total shipments of 11,184,897 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) for the same period a year ago.

Hillfeed production for March 1957 amounted to 49,334 tons compared with 57,552 tons for the corresponding month last year. The breakdown was bran 23,174 (25,739) tons, shorts 19,754 (23,006) tons, and middlings 6,406 (8,807) tons. Total millfeed production for the August-March period of the current crop year amounted to 444,904 tons against 467,793 tons for the same period in the crop year 1955-56.

Ground feeds for March 1957 totalled 135,515,510 pounds compared with 149,619,566 pounds for the same month last year. The items in this group were as follows with the comparative figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed wheat 17,066,160 (20,342,280); Ground Oats 25,931,083 (31,503,386); Ground Barley 17,468,979 (19,447,717); Cracked Corn 8,790,489 (11,870,290); and Mixed Grain 66,258,799 (66,455,893).


