### GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Wheat flour production reported by Canadian mills for the month of May 1957 amounted to 2,967,866 hundredweight compared with 3,398,143 hundredweight for the same month a year ago. Total production for the August-May period of the current crop year amounted to 31,836,743 hundredweight against 33,356,033 hundredweight for the same period in the crop year 1955-56.

Flour mill operations for May 1957 averaged 63.7 per cent when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 179,073 hundredweight. Mills reporting in April operated 63.7 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 25 days.

Wheat used in the manufacture of flour in May 1957 amounted to 6,683,825 bushels, while for the same month last year the wheat used amounted to 7,769,603 bushels. The quantity of wheat going into flour for the August-May period of the current crop year totalled 72,040,545 bushels compared with 76,291,890 bushels for the same period of the previous crop year.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of May 1957 amounted to 2,294,878 bushels for flour and 77,385 bushels of feed wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour products for May 1957 amounted to 171,691 hundredweight compared with 206,220 hundredweight for the month of May last year. This brought the total for this grade of flour to 1,808,740 hundredweight for the August-May period of the current crop year compared with 2,007,066 hundredweight for the same period in 1955-56.

According to the publication 'Trade of Canada', exports of wheat flour for May 1957 amounted to 1,007,226 hundredweight, bringing the total shipments for the August-May period of the current crop year to 13,028,981 hundredweight compared with total shipments of 14,251,600 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) for the same period a year ago.

Millfeed production for May 1957 amounted to 49,527 tons compared with 58,763 tons for the same month last year. The breakdown was bran 22,678 (24,390) tons, shorts 21,150 (24,366) tons and middlings 5,699 (10,007) tons. Total millfeed production for the August-Hay period of the current crop year amounted to 542,057 tons compared with 583,111 tons for the same period in 1955-56.

Ground feeds for May 1957 totalled 128,815,372 pounds against 138,773,340 pounds for the same month last year. The items in the group were as follows with the comparable figures in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 18,789,060 (21,315,180); Ground Oats 27,418,422 (32,241,296); Cracked Corm 9,793,130 (11,251,212); Ground Barley 18,472,496 (18,979,630); and Mixed Grain 54,342,264 (54,986,022).
