GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

Wheat flour production for Canadian mills for July 1957 was recorded at 3,021,728 hundredweight compared with 3,498,132 hundredweight for the same month last year. The ten-year (1947-1956) July average production was 3,298,858 hundredweight. Total production of wheat flour for the crop year ending July 1957 amounted to 37,623,446 hundredweight compared with 40,148,750 hundredweight for the crop year 1955-56.

Mill operations for July 1957 averaged 65.8 per cent when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 176,659 hundredweight. Mills reporting in June operated 62.4 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 25 days. The weighted average of working capacity for the crop year 1956-57 was 69.3 per cent compared with 73.7 per cent for the previous crop year.

Wheat used for flour for July 1957 amounted to 6,833,470 bushels against 7,941,523 bushels for the same month a year ago. This brought the total wheat used for flour for the crop year 1956-57 to 85,139,037 bushels compared with 91,770,025 bushels for the previous crop year. Ontario winter wheat milled for the crop year ending July 1957 and included in the above yearly total was 4,924,882 bushels compared with 5,393,763 bushels of Ontario winter wheat milled for the crop year 1955-56.

Stocks of wheat in mill bins at the close of July 1957 amounted to 2,758,368 bushels for flour and 137,045 bushels of feed wheat.

Ontario winter wheat flour production for July 1957 amounted to 143,667 hundredweight compared with 148,152 hundredweight for the same month last year. The total 1956-57 crop year production for this grade of flour amounted to 2,126,151 hundredweight compared with 2,333,561 hundredweight in 1955-56.

According to the publication 'Trade of Canada', exports of wheat flour for July 1957 amounted to 1,166,493 hundredweight, bringing the total shipments for the crop year 1956-57 to 14,999,307 hundredweight, down in volume from last crop year's comparable total of 17,391,300 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns).

Millfeed production for July 1957 amounted to 51,978 tons compared with 60,958 tons for the corresponding month last year. The breakdown was bran 22,623 (24,303) tons, shorts 21,577 (25,109) tons and middlings 7,778 (11,546) tons. Total millfeed production for the crop year ending with July 1957 amounted to 641,886 tons compared with 703,376 tons for the crop year 1955-56.

Ground feeds for July 1957 amounted to 122,238,874 pounds compared with 120,276,676 pounds for the same month last year. The items in the total were as follows with the comparable figures in brackete and the quantities in pounds: Feed Wheat 19,300,500 (20,379,420); Ground Oats 25,369,993 (28,003,972); Ground Barley 18,135,093 (18,825,924); Cracked Corn 9,687,676 (9,757,078); and Mixed Grain 49,745,612 (43,310,282).




