#### GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada during November 1958 amounted to 3,864,000 hundredweight, representing an increase of 2 per cent over the October output of 3,791,000 hundredweight and 6 per cent above the November 1957 output of 3,638,000 hundredweight, 1 per cent greater than the ten-year (1948-1957) average production for the month of November of 3,820,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 249,000 hundredweight as against 213,000 hundredweight in November 1957. Production of wheat flour during the first four months of the current crop year amounted to 13,918,000 hundredweight compared with 13,851,000 hundredweight during the same period of the 1957-58 crop year.

Nill operations during November 1958 averaged 89.1 per cent of capacity when computed on a 24-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 181,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for October operated at 80.8 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days.

Wheat milled for flour in November 1958 amounted to 8,790,000 bushels, exceeding by 7 per cent the 8,166,000 bushels milled in November a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 587,000 bushels compared with 4,92,000 bushels of this type in November 1957. Total wheat milled for flour during the first four months of the crop year 1958-59 amounted to 31,575,000 bushels, slightly above the 31,225,000 bushels milled in the same period of the past crop year.

Stocks of wheat for flour in mill bins at the close of November 1958 amounted to 3,305,000

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports during November 1952 amounted to 1,420,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first four months of the 1958-59 crop year amounted to 5,185,000 hundredweight compared with 5,445,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time in reporting returns) in the same period of the preceding crop year.

Nillfeed production for November 1958 amounted to 66,000 tons, 8 per cent greater than the 61,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows: bran 28,000 (28,000) tons, shorts 29,000 (25,000) tons and middlings 9,000 (8,000) tons. Total millfeed production during the first four months of the crop year 1958-59 amounted to 235,000 tons compared with 234,000 tons during the same period of 1957-58.
