GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada during June 1959 amounted to 3,387,000 hundredweight, representing an increase of 5 per cent over the May output of 3,239,000 hundredweight and 1 per cent greater than the June 1958 output of 3,349,000 hundredweight, but 2 per cent less than the ten-year (1949-1958) average production for the month of June of 3,460,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 247,000 hundredweight as against 235,000 hundredweight in June 1958. Production of wheat flour during the August-June period of the 1958-59 crop year amounted to 36,521,000 hundredweight compared with 37,740,000 hundredweight produced during the same period of the 1957-58 crop year.

Mill operations during June 1959 averaged 77.7 per cent of capacity when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 168,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for May 1959 operated at 77.0 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 25 days.

Wheat milled for flour in June 1959 amounted to 7,664,000 bustels, indicating an wheat milled for flour in June 1959 amounted to 7,004,000 bushels, indicating an increase of 1 per cent over the 7,572,000 bushels milled in June a year ago. Official winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 575,000 bushels compared to 566,000 bush of this type in June 1958. Total wheat milled for flour during the Argust-June period of the 1958-crop year amounted to 82,637,000 bushels as against 85,300,000 bushels milled in the symplectic of the 1957-58 crop year.

Stocks of wheat for flour in mill bins at close of type 1958 mounted to 2,374,000

bushels.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports to 1,677,000 hundredweight exceeding by 24 per cent the May 1959 total of 1,35 relatively unchanged from the adjusted June 1958 figure of 1,679,000 hundredweight Tota for the August-June period of the 1958-59 crop year amounted to 14,828,000 hundredweight shipments compared with 16,103,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) in the same period of the 1957-58 crop year.

Millfeed production for June 1959 amounted to 57,000 tons, 1 per cent more than the 56,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows: bran 23,000 (24,000) tons, shorts 27,000 (25,000) tons and middlings 7,000 (7,000) tons. Total millfeed production during the August-June period of the 1958-59 crop year amounted to 609,000 tons, while for the same period in the 1957-58 crop year the total was 637,000 tons.






