### GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada during July 1559 amounted to 3,310,000 hundred-weight, representing an increase of 7 per cent over the July 1958 Supput of 3,000 hundredweight and 6 per cent above the ten-year (1948-1957) average production for the month of July of 3,117,000 hundredweight, but 2 per cent less than the June 1959 output of 3,387,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 193,000 hundredweight as against 161,000 hundredweight in July 1958. Production of wheat flour during the crop year 1958-59 amounted to 39,830,000 hundredweight compared with 100,620,000 hundredweight produced during the 1957-58 crop year.

Mill operations during July 1959 averaged 76.0 per cent of Papacity when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 168,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for June 1959 operated at 77.7 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 tays.

Wheat milled for flour in July 1959 amounted to 7,514,000 bushels, indicating an increase of 8 per cent over the 6,989,000 bushels milled in July a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 469,000 bushels compared with 383,000 bushels of this type for July 1958. Total wheat milled for flour for the crop year 1958-59 amounted to 90,151,000 bushels compared with 92,289,000 bushels for the same period in 1957-58.

Stocks of wheat for flour in mill bins at the close of July 1959 amounted to 2,568,000 bushels.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports during July 1959 amounted to 1,114,000 hundredweight representing a decrease of 34 per cent from the June total of 1,677,000 hundredweight and 23 per cent less than the adjusted July 1958 figure of 1,453,000 hundredweight. Total shipments for the crop year 1958-59 amounted to 15,943,000 hundredweight compared with 17,557,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) during the 1957-58 crop year.

Millfeed production for July 1959 amounted to 56,000 tons, 7 per cent greater than the 52,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows: bran 23,000 (22,000) tons, shorts 26,000 (23,000) tons and middlings 7,000 (7,000) tons. Total millfeed production during the crop year 1958-59 amounted to 664,000 tons, compared with 689,000 tons in the 1957-58 crop year.









## WHEAT FLOUR PRODUCTION
