## GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada during January 1960 amounted to 2,980,000 hundred-weight, representing a decrease of 9 per cent from the January 1959 output of 3,263,000 hundredweight, 8 per cent lower than the December 1959 output of 3,244,000 hundredweight and 10 per cent less than the ten-year (1950-1959) average production for the month of January of 3,321,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 177,000 hundredweight as against 217,000 hundredweight in January 1959. Production of wheat flour during the first half of the 1959-60 crop year amounted to 20,412,000 hundredweight compared with 20,609,000 hundredweight produced during the same period of the past crop year.

Mill operations during January 1960 averaged 70.4 per cent of capacity when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 169,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for December 1959 operated at 73.5 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days.

Wheat milled for flour in January 1960 amounted to 6,727,000 bushels, 9 per cent below the 7,357,000 bushels milled in January a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 422,000 bushels compared with 508,000 bushels of this type in January 1959. Total wheat milled for flour for the first half of the current crop year amounted to 46,310,000 bushels, slightly less than the 46,724,000 bushels milled in the same period of the 1958-59 crop year.

Stocks of wheat for flour in mill bins at the close of January 1960 amounted to 3,330,000 bushels.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports during January 1960, amounted to 1,337,000 hundredweight, representing a decrease of 14 per cent below the December 1959 total of 1,547,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first six months of the 1959-60 crop year amounted to 8,586,000 hundredweight, 8 per cent greater than the 7,942,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) in the same period of the preceding crop year.

Millfeed production for January 1960 amounted to 49,000 tons, 7 per cent less than the 53,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows: bran 21,000 (22,000) tons, shorts 23,000 (25,000) tons and middlings 6,000 (6,000) tons. Total millfeed production during the first six months of the crop year 1959-60 amounted to 347,000 tons compared with 344,000 tons during the same period of 1958-59.


