# GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada for May 1960 amounted to 3,253,000 hundredweight, representing an increase of 4 per cent over the April output of 3,141,000 hundredweight, relatively unchanged from the May 1959 total of 3,239,000 hundredweight but 9 per cent less than the ten-year (1950-1959) average production for the month of May of 3,586,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 212,000 hundredweight as against 208,000 hundredweight in May 1959. Production of wheat flour during the August-May period of the current crop year amounted to 33,495,000 hundredweight compared with 33,130,000 hundredweight produced during the same period of the past crop year.

Mill operations during May 1960 averaged 76.6 per cent of capacity when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 170,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for April 1960 operated at 74.1 per cent of their combined rated capacity also for 25 days.

Wheat milled for flour in May 1960 amounted to 7,377,000 bushels, exceeding by 1 per cent the 7,298,000 bushels milled in May a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 491,000 bushels compared with 483,000 bushels of this type in May 1959. Total wheat milled for flour during the August-May period of the 1959-60 crop year amounted to 75,903,000 bushels, 1 per cent greater than the 74,964,000 bushels milled in the same period of the 1958-59 crop year.

Stocks of wheat for flour in mill bins at the close of May 1960 amounted to 2,559,000 bushels.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports during May 1960 amounted to 1,670,000 hundredweight representing an increase of 53 per cent above the April total of 1,090,000 hundredweight and 9 per cent more than the adjusted May 1959 figure of 1,534,000 hundredweight. Total shipments for the August-May period of the current crop year amounted to 13,622,000 hundredweight, 2 per cent greater than the 13,301,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) in the same period of the 1958-59 crop year.

Millfeed production for May 1960 amounted to 56,000 tons, 4 per cent more than the 53,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran 23,000 (23,000) tons, shorts 25,000 (24,000) tons and middlings 7,000 (6,000) tons. Total millfeed production for the August-May period of the 1959-60 crop year amounted to 567,000 tons, 3 per cent above the 551,000 tons produced during the same period of 1958-59.




