GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada during July 1960 amounted to 3,199,000 hundredweight, representing a decrease of 12 per cent from the previous month's output of 3,648,000 hundredweight, 3 per cent less than the July 1959 output of 3,310,000 hundredweight, but 1 per cent higher than the tan-year (1950-59) average production for the month of July of 3,158,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 183,000 hundredweight as against 193,000 hundredweight in July 1959. Production of wheat flour during the crop year 1959-60 amounted to 40,345,000 hundredweight, 1 per cent above the 39,826,000 hundredweight produced during 1958-59.

Mill operations during July 1960 averaged 75.0 per cent of capacity when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 171,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for June 1960 operated at 82.3 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days.

Wheat milled for flour in July 1960 amounted to 7,234,000 bushels, 4 per cent less than the 7,514,000 bushels milled in July a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 372,000 bushels compared with 469,000 bushels of this type in July 1959. Total wheat milled for flour during the crop year 1959-60 amounted to 91,407,000 bushels, 1 per cent greater than the 90,143,000 bushels milled in 1958-59.

Stocks of wheat for flour in mill bins at the close of July 1960 amounted to 2,642,000 bushels.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports during July 1960 amounted to 1,573,000 hundredweight representing an increase of 47 per cent above the June total of 1,072,000 hundredweight and 3 per cent more than the adjusted July 1959 figure of 1,534,000 hundredweight. Total shipments for the crop year 1959-60 amounted to 16,267,000 hundredweight compared with 16,141,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) during 1958-59.

Millfeed production for July 1960 amounted to 54,000 tons, 3 per cent less than the 56,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran 22,000 (23,000) tons, shorts 26,000 (26,000) tons and middlings 7,000 (7,000) tons. Total millfeed production during the crop year 1959-60 amounted to 684,000 tons, 3 per cent over the 663,000 tons produced during 1958-59.









WHEAT FLOUR PRODUCTION






WHEAT FLOUR EXPORTS
