GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada during December 1961 amounted to 3,085,000 hundred-weight, representing a decrease of 16 per cent from the November 1961 output of 3,668,000 hundredweight, 2 per cent lower than the December 1960 total of 3,144,000 hundredweight and 7 per cent below the ten-year (1951-60) average production for the month of December of 3,319,000 hundredweight. The preliminary total of wheat flour produced during the calendar year 1961 was 38,759,000 hundredweight compared with the revised 1960 total of 40,724,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 197,000 hundredweight as against 186,000 hundredweight in December 1960. Production of wheat flour during the first five months (August-December) of the 1961-62 crop year amounted to 16,655,000 hundredweight, compared with 17,811,000 hundredweight produced during the same period of the 1960-61 crop year. Mill operations during December 1961 averaged 83.0 per cent of capacity when computed on a 24-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 155,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for November operated at 93.8 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 25 days.

Wheat milled for flour in December 1961 amounted to 6,891,000 bushels, indicating a decrease of 16 per cent from the 8,196,000 bushels milled in November 1961 and 2 per cent less than the 7,065,000 bushels milled in December a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 502,000 bushels compared with 438,000 bushels of this type in December 1960. Total wheat milled for flour during the first five months of the crop year 1961-62 amounted to 37,285,000 bushels as against 40,252,000 bushels milled in the same period of 1960-61. Millfeed production for December 1961 amounted to 50,000 tons, 5 per cent less than the 53,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran 21,000 (24,000) tons, shorts 25,000 (24,000) tons and middlings 4,000 (6,000) tons.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports for the month of October 1961 amounted to 1,171,000 hundredweight, representing an increase of 5 per cent over the September figure of 1,113,000 hundredweight but 28 per cent below the adjusted October 1960 exports of 1,620,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first three months of the 1961-62 crop year amounted to 3,823,000 hundredweight compared with 4,038,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) in the same period of the preceding crop year.

NOTE: Due to the introduction of a new commodity classification effective January 1, 1961, official wheat flour export data for November and December included in this report represents an unofficial estimate.


