GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada during July 1961 amounted to 3,389,000 hundred-weight representing an increase of 8 per cent over the June 1961 output of 3,150,000 hundredweight, 6 per cent greater than the July 1960 total of 3,198,000 hundredweight, and 5 per cent above the ten-year (1951-60) average production for the month of July of 3,225,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 118,000 hundredweight as against 182,000 hundredweight in July 1960. Production of wheat flour during the crop year 1960-61 amounted to 39,912,000 hundredweight, 2 per cent less than the 40,345,000 hundredweight produced during 1959-60.

Mill operations during July 1961 averaged 83.9 per cent of capacity when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 155,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for June 1961 operated at 78.2 per cent of their combined rated capacity for the same number of days.

Wheat milled for flour in July 1961 amounted to 7,561,000 bushels, 5 per cent more than the 7,233,000 bushels milled in July a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 427,000 bushels compared with 371,000 bushels of this type in July 1960. Total wheat milled for flour during the crop year 1960-61 amounted to 89,725,000 bushels, 2 per cent less than the 91,390,000 bushels milled in the preceding crop year.

Millfeed production for July 1961 amounted to 56,000 tons, 3 per cent higher than the 54,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran 23,000 (22,000) tons, shorts 28,000 (26,000) tons and middlings 3,000 (7,000) tons. Total millfeed production during the crop year 1960-61 amounted to 668,000 tons compared with 684,000 tons produced during 1959-60.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports during May 1961 amounted to 1,233,000 hundredweight, representing a decrease of 15 per cent from the April 1961 total of 1,454,000 hundredweight and 19 per cent lower than the May 1960 adjusted total of 1,531,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first ten months of the 1960-61 crop year amounted to 13,289,000 hundredweight compared with 13,359,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) in the same period of the preceding crop year.

NOTE:

Due to the introduction of a new commodity classification effective January 1, 1961, official wheat flour export data for June and July were not available at the time of preparation of this report. The flour export figure for both June and July included in this report represents an unofficial estimate.










WHEAT FLOUR PRODUCTION
