GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada during January 1962 amounted to 3,093,000 hundred-weight, slightly above the December 1961 output of 3,085,000 hundredweight, 14 per cent higher than the January 1961 total of 2,719,000 hundredweight, but 3 per cent less than the ten-year (1952-61) average production for the month of January of 3,198,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 195,000 hundredweight as against 203,000 hundredweight in January 1961. Production of wheat flour during the first half of the 1961-62 crop year amounted to 19,748,000 hundredweight compared with 20,530,000 hundredweight produced during the same period of the past crop year. Mill operations during January 1962 averaged 76.1 per cent of capacity when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 156,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for December 1961 operated at 83.0 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 24 days.

Wheat milled for flour in January 1962 amounted to 6,920,000 bushels compared with 6,891,000 bushels milled in December 1961, and 6,090,000 bushels milled in January a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 520,000 bushels compared with 467,000 bushels of this type in January 1961. Total wheat milled for flour for the first half of the current crop year amounted to 44,205,000 bushels as against 46,342,000 bushels milled in the same period of 1960-61. Millfeed production for January 1962 amounted to 51,000 tons, 13 per cent more than the 45,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran 21,000 (19,000) tons, shorts 26,000 (21,000) tons and middlings 4,000 (5,000) tons. Total millfeed production during the first six months of the crop year 1961-62 amounted to 327,000 tons compared with 348,000 tons during the same period of the preceding crop year.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports for the month of November 1961 amounted to 1,059,000 hundredweight, as against 1,171,000 hundredweight exported during the preceding month and the adjusted November 1960 total of 1,825,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first four months of the 1961-62 crop year amounted to 4,882,000 hundredweight compared with 5,863,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) during the same period of the 1960-61 crop year.

NOTE: Due to the introduction of a new commodity classification effective January 1, 1961, official wheat flour export data for December 1961 and January 1962 included in this report represents an unofficial estimate.
