GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada during April 1962 amounted to 2,725,000 hundredweight, representing a decrease of 22 per cent from the March output of 3,516,000 hundredweight, 11 per cent below the April 1961 total of 3,066,000 hundredweight, and 19 per cent lower than the ten-year (1952-61) average production for the month of April of 3,352,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 214,000 hundredweight as against 205,000 hundredweight in April 1961. Production of wheat flour during the first nine months (August-April) of the 1961-62 crop year amounted to 28,816,000 hundredweight compared with 29,950,000 hundredweight produced during the same period of the past crop year. Mill operations during April 1962 averaged 69.1 per cent of capacity when computed on a 24-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 164,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for March 1962 operated at 79.5 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 27 days.

Wheat milled for flour in April 1962 amounted to 6,057,000 bushels, 23 per cent below the 7,843,000 bushels milled in March and 12 per cent less than the 6,863,000 bushels milled in April a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 527,000 bushels, compared with 477,000 bushels of this type in April 1961. Total wheat milled for flour during the August-April period of the 1961-62 crop year amounted to 64,429,000 bushels as against 67,441,000 bushels milled in the same period of the 1960-61 crop year. Millfeed production for April 1962 amounted to 45,000 tons, 12 per cent less than the 51,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran 19,000 (24,000) tons, shorts 21,000 (22,000) tons and middlings 4,000 (5,000) tons. Total millfeed production during the first nine months of the crop year 1961-62 amounted to 476,000 tons compared with 503,000 tons during the same period of the preceding crop year.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports for the month of February 1962 amounted to 983,000 hundredweight, representing a decrease of 7 per cent from the 1,052,000 hundredweight exported during the previous month and 6 per cent below the adjusted February 1961 total of 1,045,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first seven months of the 1961-62 crop year amounted to 8,237,000 hundredweight compared with 9,267,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) during the same period of the 1960-61 crop year.

NOTE:

Due to the introduction of a new commodity classification effective January 1, 1961, official wheat flour export data for April 1962 included in this report represents an unofficial estimate.
