### GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada during July 1962 amounted to 3,732,000 hundredweight representing an increase of 3 per cent over the June output of 3,631,000 hundredweight, 10 per cent greater than the July 1961 total of 3,389,000 hundredweight, and 13 per cent above the ten-year (1952-61) average production for the month of July of 3,289,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 210,000 hundredweight as against 184,000 hundredweight in July 1961. Production of wheat flour during the crop year 1961-62 amounted to 39,538,000 hundredweight 1 per cent below the 39,915,000 hundredweight produced during 1960-61.
Mill operations during July 1962 averaged 91.4 per cent of capacity when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 163,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for June operated at 85.6 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days.

Wheat milled for flour in July 1962 amounted to 8,271,000 bushels, 3 per cent more than the 8,051,000 bushels milled in June and 9 per cent higher than the 7,561,000 bushels milled in July a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 547,000 bushels compared with 427,000 bushels of this type in July 1961. Total wheat milled for flour during the crop year 1961-62 amounted to 88,224,000 bushels, 2 per cent less than the 89,731,000 bushels milled in the preceding crop year. Millfeed production for July 1962 amounted to 61,000 tons, 9 per cent above the 56,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran 25,000 (23,000) tons, shorts 30,000 (28,000) tons and middlings 6,000 (5,000) tons. Total millfeed production during the crop year 1961-62 amounted to 653,000 tons, 2 per cent less than the 668,000 tons produced during 1960-61/

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports for the month of July 1962 amounted to 1,120,000 hundredweight, representing an increase of 14 per cent over the 983,000 hundredweight exported during the previous month but 1 per cent less than the adjusted July 1961/10tal of 1,133,000 hundredweight. Total shipments for the crop year 1961-62 amounted to 13,879,000 hundredweight, compared with 15,514,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) during 1960-61.
