GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada during February 1963 amounted to 2,815,000 hundred-weight, representing an increase of 1 per cent over both the January 1963 total of 2,793,000 hundred-weight and the February 1962 figure of 2,782,000 hundredweight, but 10 per cent below the ten-year (1953-62) average production for the month of February of 3,132,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 227,000 hundredweight as against 178,000 hundredweight in February 1962. Production of wheat flour during the first seven months of the 1962-63 crop year amounted to 20,254,000 hundredweight compared with 22,574,000 hundredweight produced during the same period of the past crop year. Mill operations during February 1963 averaged 70.5 per cent of capacity when computed on a 24-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 166,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for January 1963 operated at 64.5 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days.

Wheat milled for flour in February 1963 amounted to 6,250,000 bushels, indicating an increase of 1 per cent above both the 6,198,000 bushels milled in January 1963 and the 6,218,000 bushels milled in February a year ago. Onterio winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 540,000 bushels compared with 450,000 bushels of this type in February 1962. Total wheat milled for flour during the August-February period of the 1962-63 crop year amounted to 44,990,000 bushels compared with 50,542,000 bushels milled in the same period of 1961-62. Millfeed production for February 1963 amounted to 46,000 tons unchanged from the 46,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran, 21,000 (19,000) tons; shorts, 21,000 (23,000) tons and middlings 4,000 (4,000) tons. Total millfeed production during the first seven months of the 1962-63 crop year amounted to 330,000 tons compared with 373,000 tons produced during the same period of the preceding crop year.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports for the month of February 1963 amounted to 617,000 hundredweight, as against the 971,000 hundredweight exported during January 1963 and the adjusted February 1962 total of 1,107,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first seven months of the 1962-63 crop year amounted to 6,801,000 hundredweight compared with 8,236,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) during the same period of the 1961-62 crop year.
