GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada during June 1963 amounted to 3,029,000 hundredweight, indicating a decrease of 10 per cent from the May output of 3,357,000 hundredweight, 17 per cent below the June 1962 total of 3,631,000 hundredweight and 10 per cent less than the ten-year (1953-62) average production for the month of June of 3,383,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 222,000 hundredweight as against 234,000 hundredweight in June 1962. Production of wheat flour during the August-June period of the 1962-63 crop year amounted to 32,638,000 hundredweight compared with 35,803,000 hundredweight produced during the same period of the past crop year. Mill operations during June 1963 averaged 73.4 per cent of capacity when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 165,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for May 1963 operated at 78.1 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days.

Wheat milled for flour in June 1963 amounted to 6,775,000 bushels, representing a decrease of 9 per cent from the 7,406,000 bushels milled in May 1963 and 16 per cent less than the 8,052,000 bushels milled in June a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 527,000 bushels as against 586,000 bushels of this type in June 1962. Total wheat milled for flour during the first eleven months of the 1962-63 crop year amounted to 72,446,000 bushels 9 per cent less than the 79,960,000 bushels milled in the same period of 1961-62. Millfeed production for June 1963 amounted to 49,000 tons compared with the 59,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran, 20,000 (24,000) tons; shorts, 25,000 (30,000) tons and middlings, 5,000 (6,000) tons. Total millfeed production during the first eleven months of the 1962-63 crop year amounted to 529,000 tons compared with the 590,000 tons produced during the same period of the preceding crop year.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports for the month of June 1963 amounted to 1,171,000 hundredweight, 5 per cent below the 1,229,000 hundredweight exported during May 1963, but 10 per cent higher than the adjusted June 1962 total of 1,068,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first eleven months of the 1962-63 crop year amounted to 11,106,000 hundredweight compared with 12,714,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) during the same period of the 1961-62 crop year.

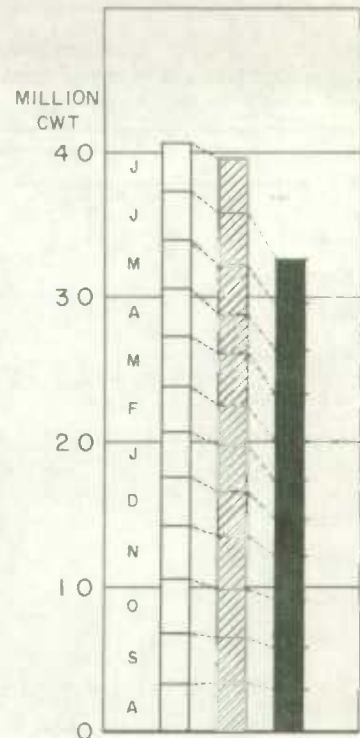
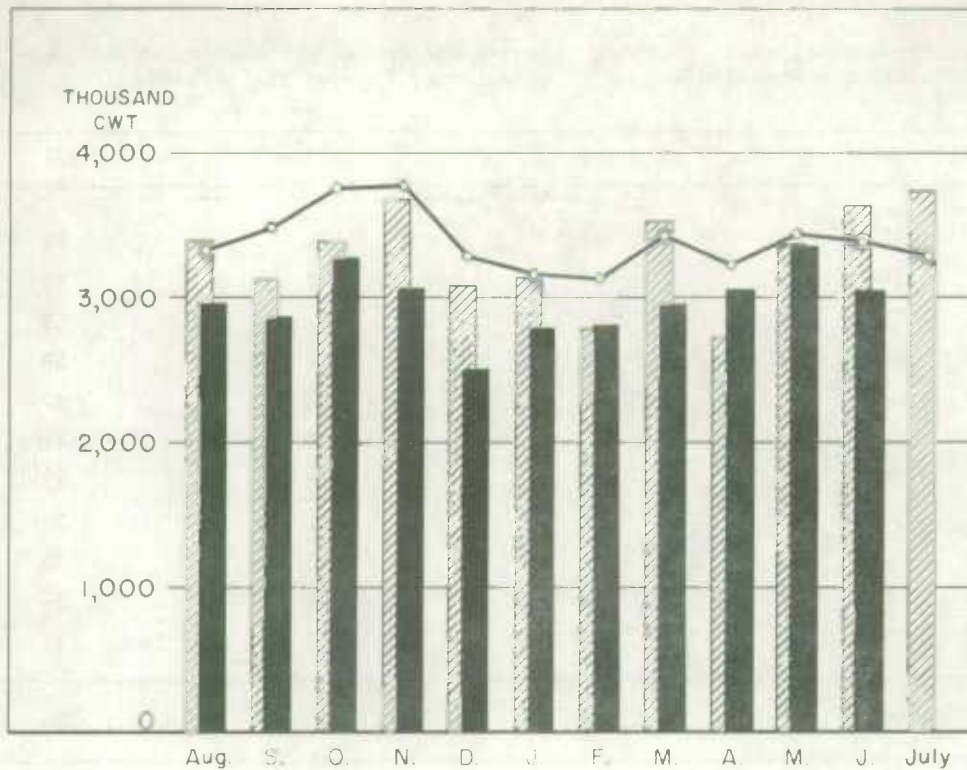

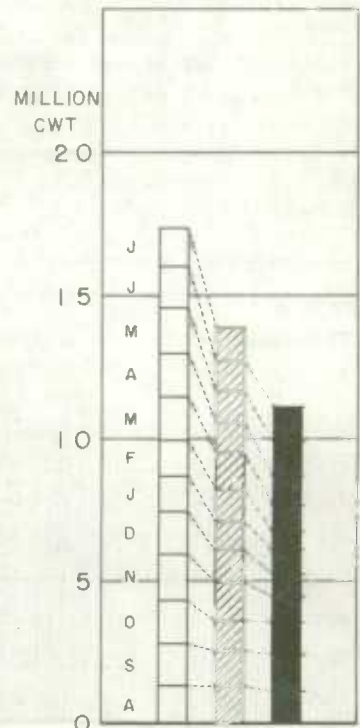
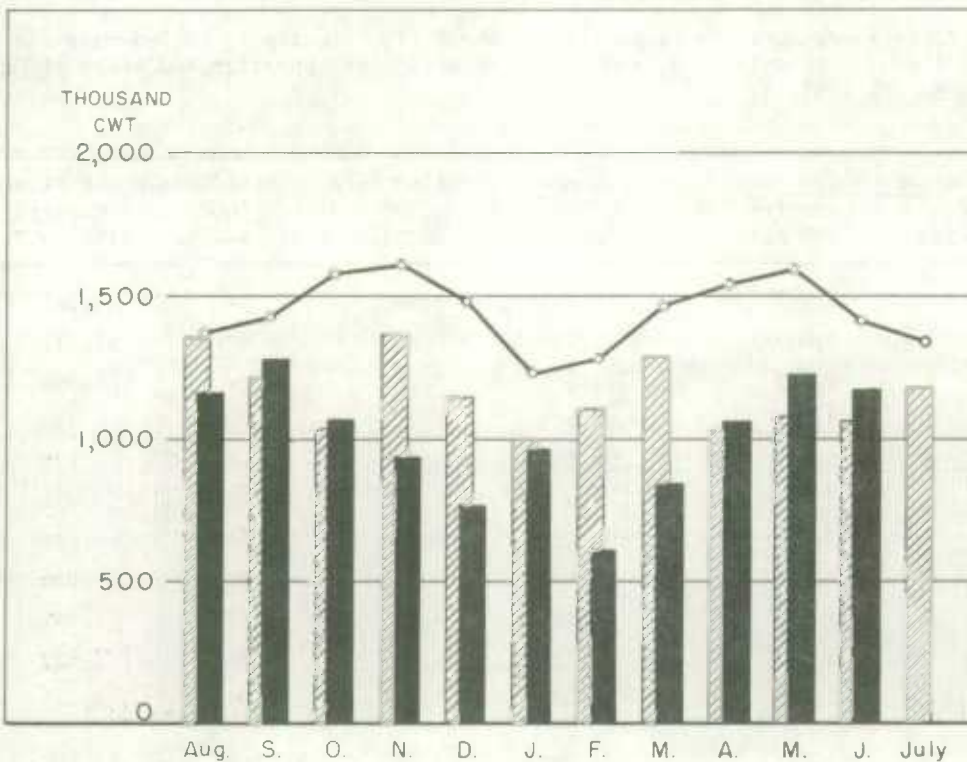
