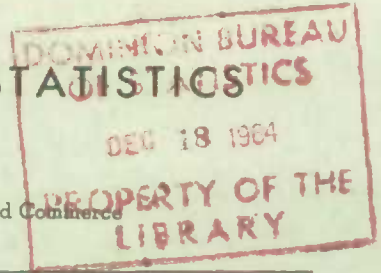

GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada for October 1964 amounted to 3,389,000 hundredweight, relatively unchanged from the September 1964 output of 3,373,000 hundredweight, 27 per cent lower than the October 1963 figure of 4,668,000 hundredweight and 9 per cent below the ten-year (1954-63) average production for the month of October of 3,718,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 273,000 hundredweight as against 258,000 hundredweight in October 1963. Production of wheat flour during the first three months of the current crop year amounted to 9,907,000 hundredweight 10 per cent less than the 11,131,000 hundredweight produced during the same period of the 1963-64 crop year.

Mill operations during October 1964 averaged 77.0 per cent of capacity when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 169,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for September operated at 80.0 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 25 days.

Wheat milled for flour in October 1964 amounted to 7,609,000 bushels, 1 per cent more than the 7,500,000 bushels milled in September but 27 per cent below the 10,423,000 bushels milled in October a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 644,000 bushels compared with 605,000 bushels of this type for October 1963. Total wheat milled for flour during the first three months of the crop year 1964-65 amounted to 22,137,000 bushels 11 per cent less than the 24,855,000 bushels milled in the same period of the preceding crop year.

Millfeed production for October 1964 amounted to 58,000 tons 23 per cent lower than the 76,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran 23,000 (32,000) tons, shorts 29,000 (38,000) tons and middlings 6,000 (6,000) tons. Total millfeed production for the first three months of the 1964-65 crop year amounted to 167,000 tons 8 per cent lower than the 181,000 tons produced in the previous crop year.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports for the month of October 1964 amounted to 886,000 hundredweight, representing a decrease of 4 per cent from the September figure of 927,000 hundredweight and 42 per cent below the adjusted October 1963 exports of 1,531,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first three months of the 1964-65 crop year amounted to 3,584,000 hundredweight 2 per cent lower than the 3,672,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) in the same period of the preceding crop year.

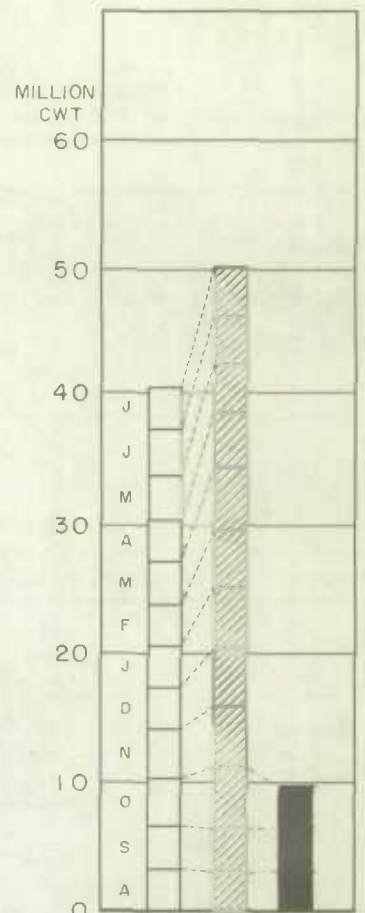

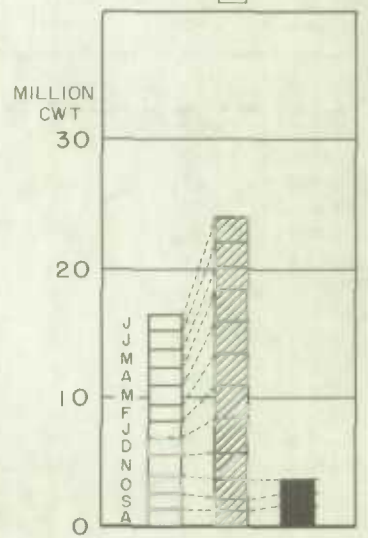
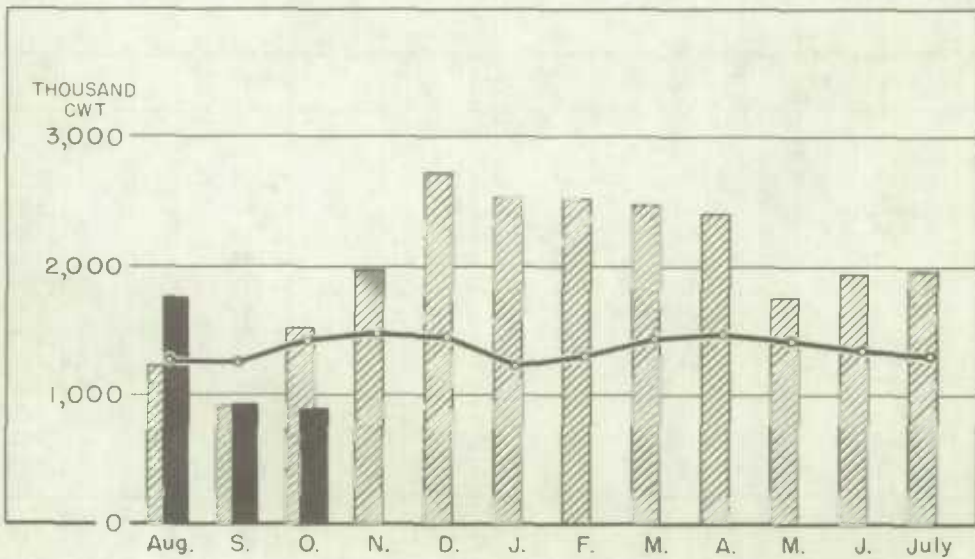
