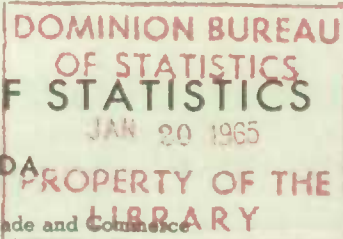

GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada for November 1964 amounted to 3,385,000 hundredweight, relatively unchanged from the October 1964 output of 3,389,000 hundredweight, 29 per cent lower than the November 1963 total of 4,737,000 hundredweight and 10 per cent less than the ten-year (1954-63) average production for the month of November of 3,753,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 248,000 hundredweight compared with the 235,000 hundredweight in November 1963. Production of wheat flour during the first four months of the current crop year amounted to 13,293,000 hundredweight, 16 per cent below the 15,868,000 hundredweight produced during the same period of the 1963-64 crop year.

Mill operations during November 1964 averaged 83.6 per cent of capacity when computed on a 24-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 169,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for October 1964 operated at 77.0 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days.

Wheat milled for flour in November 1964 amounted to 7,518,000 bushels, representing a decrease of 1 per cent from the 7,609,000 bushels milled in October 1964 and 29 per cent lower than the 10,565,000 bushels milled in November a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 592,000 bushels compared with 560,000 bushels of this type for November 1963. Total wheat milled for flour during the first four months of the crop year 1964-65 amounted to 29,655,000 bushels, 16 per cent less than the 35,420,000 bushels milled in the same period of the preceding crop year.

Millfeed production for November 1964 amounted to 55,000 tons, 29 per cent below the 77,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran, 23,000 (33,000) tons; shorts, 29,000 (38,000) tons; and middlings, 3,000 (6,000) tons. Total millfeed production for the first four months of the 1964-65 crop year amounted to 222,000 tons, 14 per cent below the 258,000 tons produced in the previous crop year.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports for the month of November 1964 amounted to 1,097,000 hundredweight, representing an increase of 24 per cent over the October 1964 figure of 886,000 hundredweight but 44 per cent lower than the adjusted November 1963 exports of 1,973,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first four months of the 1964-65 crop year amounted to 4,681,000 hundredweight 17 per cent less than the 5,645,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) in the same period of the preceding crop year.

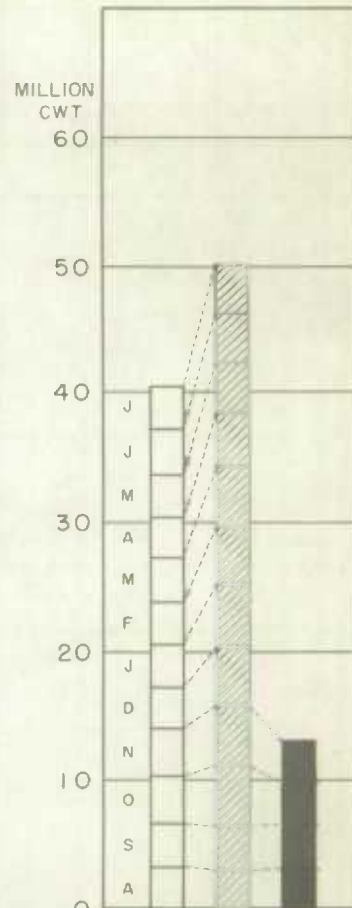
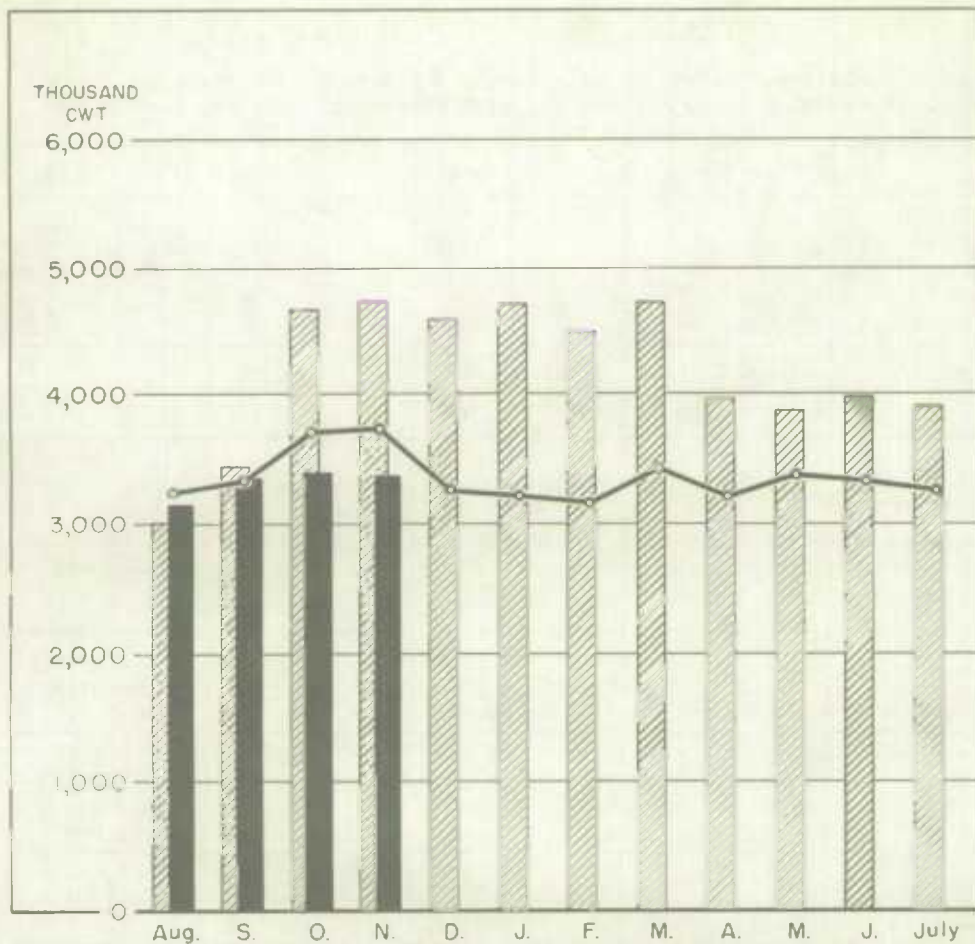
