GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada for May 1964 amounted to 3,881,000 hundredweight 2 per cent below the April 1964 total of 3,960,000 hundredweight but 16 per cent greater than both the May 1963 figure of 3,357,000 hundredweight and the ten-year (1954-63) average production for the month of May of 3,343,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 238,000 hundredweight compared with 208,000 hundredweight in May 1963. Production of wheat flour during the first ten months (August-May) of the 1963-64 crop year amounted to 42,233,000 hundredweight, 43 per cent larger than the 29,617,000 hundredweight produced during the same period last year. Mill operations during May 1964 averaged 88.1 per cent of capacity when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 176,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for April 1964 operated at 86.7 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days. Many mills, because of a large volume of forward commitments had operated at more than the standard number of working days during the six-month period, October to March.

Wheat milled for flour in May 1964 amounted to 8,635,000 bushels, 2 per cent lower than the 8,818,000 bushels milled in April 1964 but 17 per cent above the May 1963 total of 7,406,000 bushels. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 561,000 bushels compared with 495,000 bushels of this type in May 1963. Total wheat milled for flour for the August-May period of the 1963-64 crop year amounted to 94,059,000 bushels in contrast to 65,665,000 bushels milled in the same period of 1962-63. Millfeed production for May 1964 amounted to 62,000 tons, 16 per cent above the 54,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran, 26,000 (23,000) tons, shorts, 32,000 (26,000) tons and middlings, 4,000 (5,000) tons. Total millfeed production during the first ten months of the 1963-64 crop year amounted to 681,000 tons, as against the 479,000 tons produced during the same period of the preceding crop year.

According to preliminary Customs' returns, wheat flour exports for the month of May 1964 amounted to 1,768,000 hundredweight, 39 per cent lower than the 2,886,000 hundredweight exported during April 1964 but in sharp contrast to the adjusted May 1963 exports of 950,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first ten months of the 1963-64 crop year amounted to 19,844,000 hundredweight, more than double the 9,776,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) exported in the same period of the preceding crop year.
