GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada for September 1964 amounted to 3,373,000 hundredweight, representing an increase of 7 per cent greater than the August 1964 output of 3,145,000 hundredweight, 1 per cent above the ten-year (1954-63) average production for the month of September of 3,350,000 hundredweight but 3 per cent below the September 1963 total of 3,459,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 236,000 hundredweight as against 267,000 hundredweight in September 1963. Production of wheat flour during the first two months of the current crop year amounted to 6,518,000 hundredweight 1 per cent more than the 6,463,000 hundredweight produced during the same period of the 1963-64 crop year.

Mill operations during September 1964 averaged 80.0 per cent of capacity when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 169,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for August operated at 70.9 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 26 days.

Wheat milled for flour in September 1964 amounted to 7,500,000 bushels, 7 per cent more than the 7,028,000 bushels milled in August but 3 per cent less than the 7,712,000 bushels milled in September a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 566,000 bushels compared with 631,000 bushels of this type for September 1963. Total wheat milled for flour during the first two months of the crop year 1964-65 amounted to 14,528,000 bushels 1 per cent above the 14,432,000 bushels milled in the same period of the preceding crop year.

Millfeed production for September 1964 amounted to 56,000 tons unchanged from the 56,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran 22,000 (23,000) tons, shorts 28,000 (28,000) tons and middlings 6,000 (5,000) tons. Total millfeed production for the first two months of the 1964-65 crop year amounted to 109,000 tons 4 per cent more than the 105,000 tons produced in the previous crop year.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports for the month of September 1964 amounted to 927,000 hundredweight 48 per cent lower than the 1,771,000 hundredweight exported in August 1964, but 1 per cent more than the adjusted September 1963 exports of 916,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first two months of the 1964-65 crop year amounted to 2,698,000 hundredweight 26 per cent greater than the 2,141,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) in the same period of the preceding crop year.

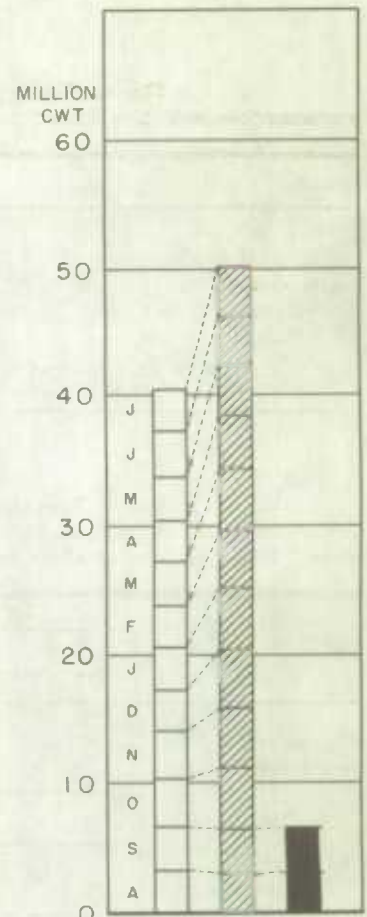
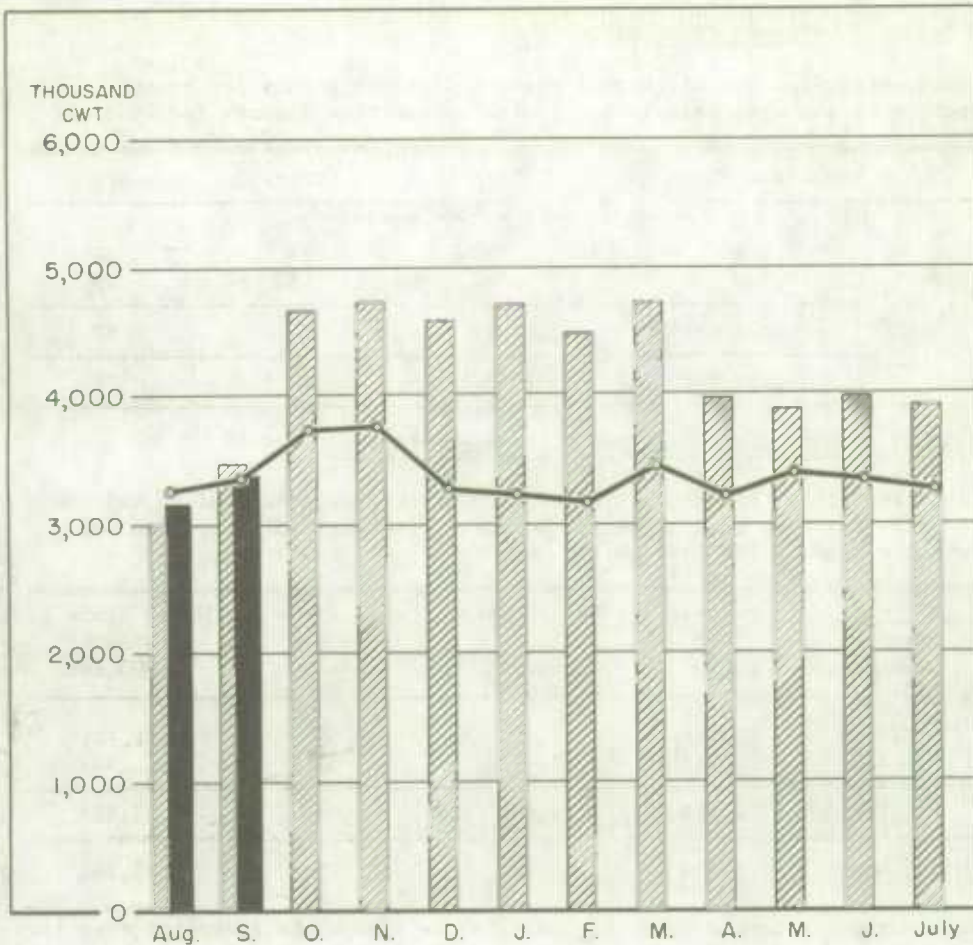

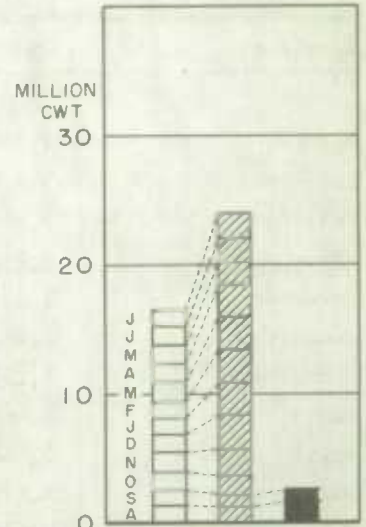
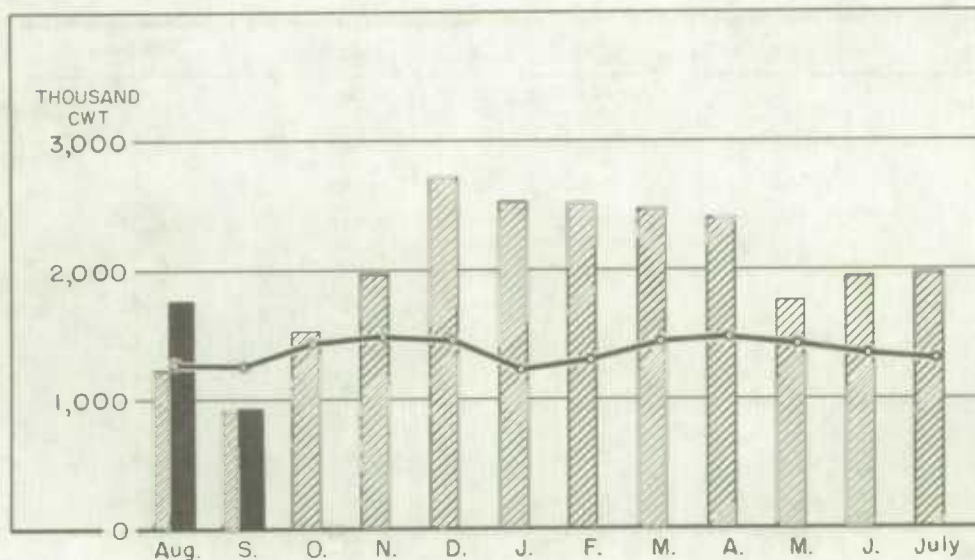
