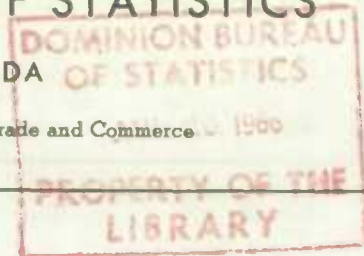

## GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada for November 1965 amounted to 3,902,000 hundredweight, representing a decrease of 5 per cent from the October 1965 output of 4,115,000 hundredweight but 15 per cent greater than the November 1964 total of 3,386,000 hundredweight and 5 per cent above the ten-year (1955-64) average production for the month of November of 3,723,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 257,000 hundredweight compared with 250,000 hundredweight in November 1964. Production of wheat flour during the August-November period of the current crop year amounted to 15,297,000 hundredweight, 15 per cent higher than the 13,294,000 hundredweight produced during the same four months of the past crop year and 11 per cent over the ten-year August-November average.

Mill operations during November 1965 averaged 93.6 per cent of capacity when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 167,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for October 1965 operated at 98.8 per cent of their combined rated capacity for the same number of days.

Wheat milled for flour in November 1965 amounted to 8,758,000 bushels, 5 per cent less than the 9,221,000 bushels milled in October 1965, but 16 per cent greater than the 7,520,000 bushels milled in November a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 620,000 bushels compared with 596,000 bushels of this type for November 1964. Total wheat milled for flour during the first four months of the crop year 1965-66 amounted to 34,281,000 bushels 16 per cent over the 29,660,000 bushels milled in the same period of the preceding year.

Millfeed production for November 1965 amounted to 64,000 tons, 16 per cent greater than the 55,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran 27,000 (23,000) tons, shorts 33,000 (29,000) tons and middlings 4,000 (3,000) tons. Total millfeed production for the first four months of the 1965-66 crop year amounted to 251,000 tons 13 per cent more than the 222,000 tons produced in the corresponding period of the previous crop year.

**NOTE:** Official wheat flour export data for November were not available at the time of preparation of this report. The flour export figure for November included in this report represents an unofficial estimate.

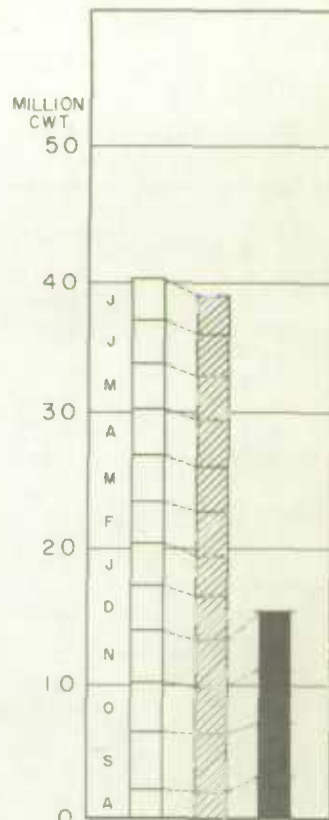
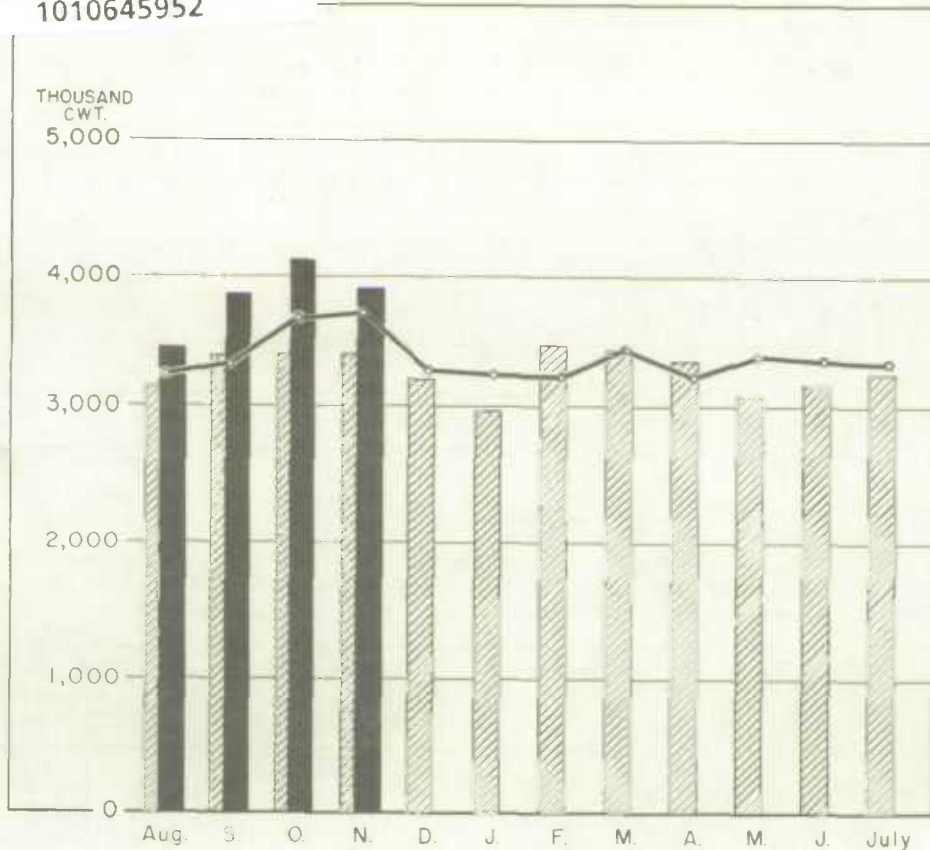

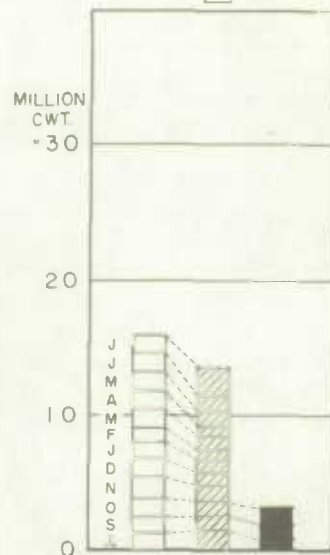
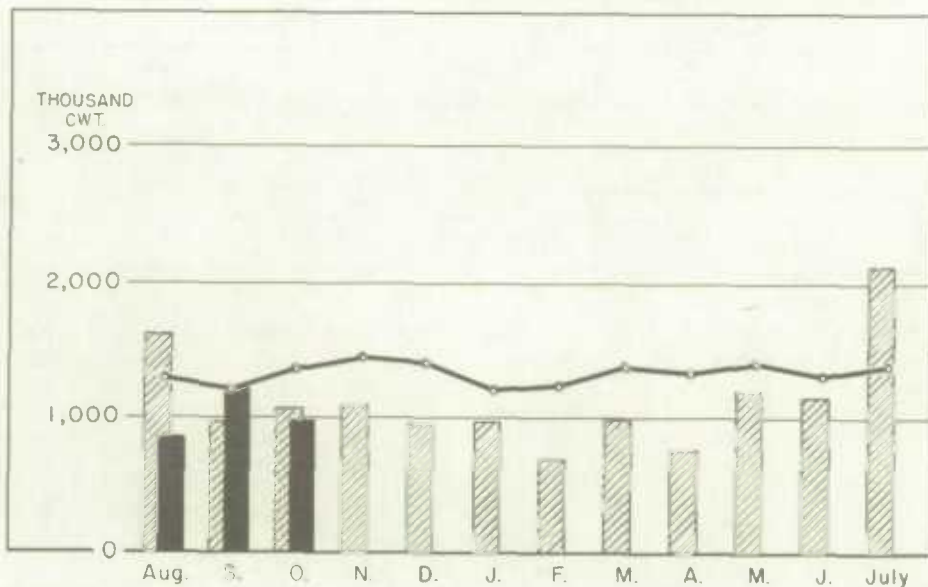
