GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada during March 1965 amounted to 3,408,000 hundredweight, representing a decrease of 1 per cent from both the February 1965 total of 3,455,000 hundredweight and the ten-year (1955-64) average production for the month of March of 3,453,000 hundredweight and 28 per cent below the March 1964 figure of 4,725,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 243,000 hundredweight compared with 217,000 hundredweight in March 1964. Production of wheat flour during the first eight months (August-March) of the 1964-65 crop year amounted to 26,316,000 hundredweight, 24 per cent below the 34,392,000 hundredweight produced during the same period of the past crop year, but only 1 per cent lower than the ten-year average for the same period. Mill operations during March 1965 averaged 76.2 per cent of capacity when computed on a 27-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 166,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for February 1965 operated at 86.8 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 24 days.

Wheat milled for flour in March 1965 amounted to 7,589,000 bushels, 1 per cent below the 7,680,000 bushels milled during the previous month and 28 per cent lower than the March 1964 total of 10,505,000 bushels. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 596,000 bushels compared with the 514,000 bushels of this type in March 1964. Total wheat milled for flour for the August-March period of the 1964-65 crop year amounted to 58,614,000 bushels, 23 per cent less than the 76,609,000 bushels milled in the same months of 1963-64, and 2 per cent below the tenyear average for the same period. Millfeed production for March 1965 amounted to 56,000 tons, 26 per cent lower than the 75,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran 25,000 (31,000) tons, shorts 28,000 (39,000) tons and middlings 3,000 (6,000) tons. Total millfeed production during the first eight months of the crop year 1964-65 amounted to 436,000 tons as against 556,000 tons produced during the same period of the preceding crop year.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports for the month of March 1965 amounted to 956,000 hundredweight, representing an increase of 65 per cent over the February 1965 figure of 579,000 hundredweight, and in sharp contrast to the adjusted March 1964 exports of 2,477,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first eight months of the 1964-65 crop year amounted to 8,364,000 hundredweight, some 47 per cent less than the 15,910,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) exported in the same period of the preceding crop year, and 21 per cent lower than the 10-year August-March average of 10,632,000 hundredweight.
