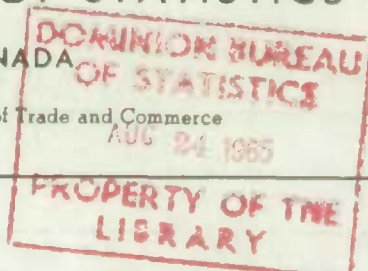

## GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada during June 1965 amounted to 3,153,000 hundredweight, 2 per cent above the May 1965 total of 3,083,000 hundredweight but 21 per cent lower than the June 1964 figure of 3,971,000 hundredweight and 6 per cent below the ten-year (1955-64) average production for the month of June of 3,343,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 250,000 hundredweight, compared with 231,000 hundredweight in June 1964. Production of wheat flour during the August-June period of the 1964-65 crop year amounted to 35,871,000 hundredweight, 22 per cent lower than the 46,203,000 hundredweight produced during the same period last year, but only 1 per cent less than the ten-year average for the same period. Mill operations during June 1965 averaged 72.5 per cent of capacity when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 167,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for May 1965 operated at 74.9 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 25 days.

Wheat milled for flour in June 1965 amounted to 7,053,000 bushels, 2 per cent more than the 6,884,000 bushels milled during the previous month, but 21 per cent below the June 1964 total of 8,893,000 bushels. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 600,000 bushels compared with 557,000 bushels of this type in June 1964. Total wheat milled for flour for the August-June period of the 1964-65 crop year amounted to 79,970,000 bushels, 22 per cent below the 102,950,000 bushels milled in the same months of 1963-64, but only 2 per cent less than the ten-year average for the same period. Millfeed production for June 1965 amounted to 52,000 tons, 22 per cent below the 67,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran, 22,000 (27,000) tons, shorts 28,000 (34,000) tons and middlings 3,000 (5,000) tons. Total millfeed production during the first eleven months of the crop year 1964-65 amounted to 594,000 tons, 21 per cent lower than the 748,000 tons produced during the same period of the preceding crop year.

According to preliminary customs returns wheat flour exports for the month of June 1965 amounted to 1,165,000 hundredweight, indicating a decrease of 3 per cent from the May 1965 figure of 1,207,000 hundredweight and 29 per cent lower than the adjusted June 1964 exports of 1,638,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first eleven months of the 1964-65 crop year amounted to 11,513,000 hundredweight some 48 per cent less than the 22,015,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) exported in the same period of the preceding crop year and 22 per cent below the 10-year August-June average of 14,825,000 hundredweight.

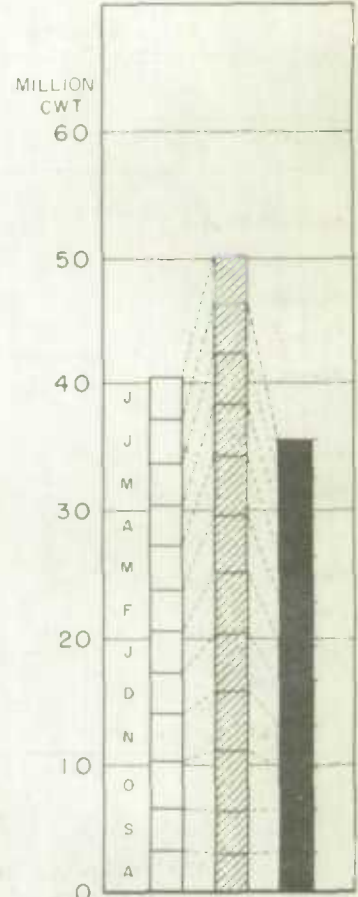
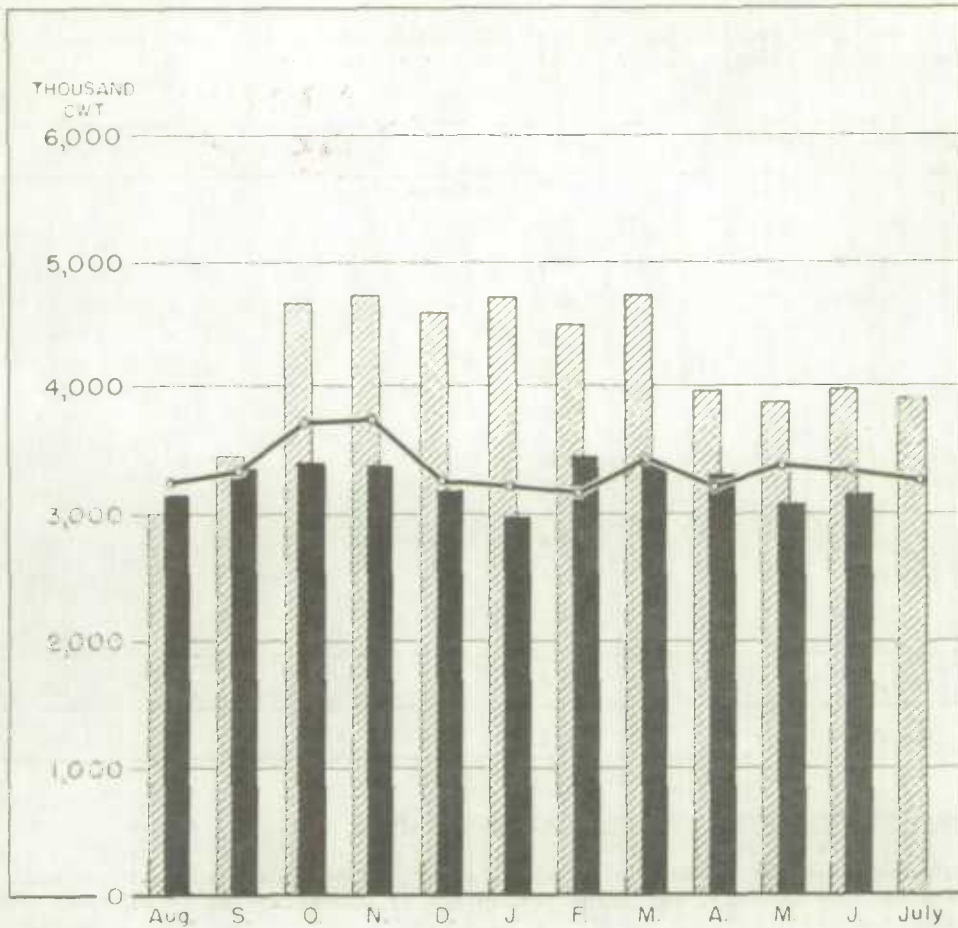

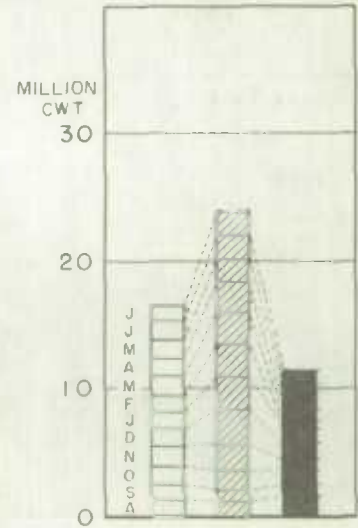
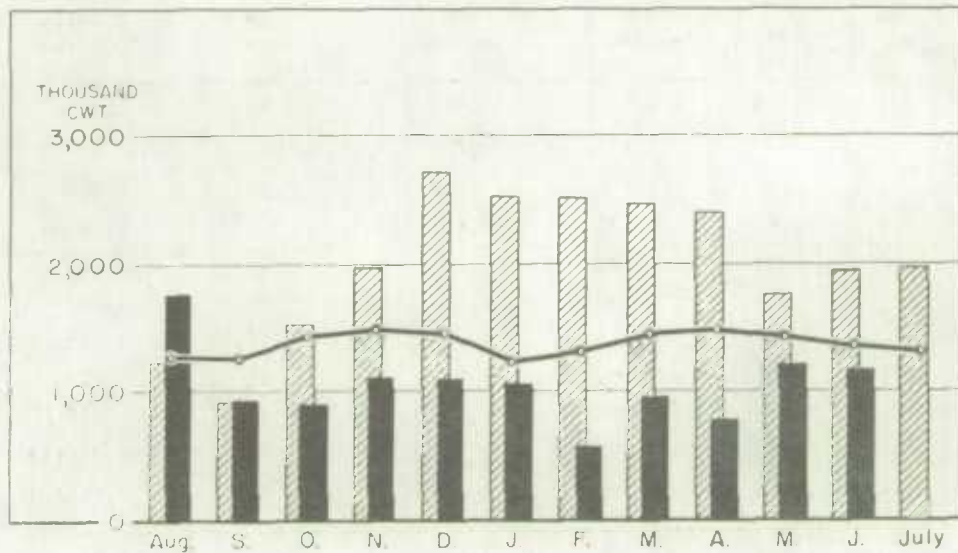
