GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada for November 1966 amounted to 3,896,000 hundred-weight, representing an increase of 5 per cent over the October 1966 output of 3,694,000 hundredweight, 4 per cent above the ten-year (1956-65) average production for the month of November of 3,750,000 hundredweight, but 3 per cent less than the November 1965 total of 3,906,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 269,000 hundredweight compared with 261,000 hundredweight in November 1965. Production of wheat flour during the August-November period of the current crop year amounted to 14,751,000 hundredweight, 4 per cent below the 15,301,000 hundredweight produced during the same four months of the previous crop year but 5 per cent above the ten-year August-November average.

Mill operations during November 1966 averaged 91.5 per cent of capacity when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 164,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for October operated at 90.0 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 25 days.

Wheat milled for flour in November 1966 amounted to 8,810,000 bushels, 5 per cent more than the 8,366,000 bushels milled in October, and slightly above the 8,768,000 bushels milled in November a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 686,000 bushels compared with 631,000 bushels of this type for November 1965. Total wheat milled for flour during the first four months of the 1966-67 crop year amounted to 33,458,000 bushels, 2 per cent below the 34,291,000 bushels milled in the same period of the preceding crop year. Millfeed production for November 1966 amounted to 66,000 tons, 3 per cent above the 64,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran, 25,000 (27,000) tons, shorts 37,000 (33,000) tons and middlings 4,000 (4,000) tons. Total millfeed production for the first four months of the 1966-67 crop year amounted to 251,000 tons, unchanged from the comparable figure of a year ago.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports for the month of October 1966 amounted to 1,514,000 hundredweight, 47 per cent higher than the revised figure of 1,030,000 hundredweight exported in September 1966 but 5 per cent below the adjusted October 1965 figure of 1,597,000 hundredweight. Exports during the first three months of the 1966-67 crop year amounted to 3,814,000 hundredweight, 1 per cent less than the 3,870,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) shipped during the same period of the preceding crop year.

NOTE: The flour export figure for the month of November included in this report represents an unofficial estimate.
