GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada for April 1966 amounted to 3,315,000 hundredweight, representing a decrease of 18 per cent from the March 1966 output of 4,056,000 hundredweight little changed from the April 1965 total of 3,311,000 hundredweight but 3 per cent above the ten-year (1956-65) average production for the month of April of 3,214,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 217,000 hundredweight compared with 221,000 hundredweight in April 1965. Production of wheat flour during the first nine months of the current crop year amounted to 33,891,000 hundredweight, 14 per cent greater than the 29,643,000 hundredweight produced during the same period of the 1964-65 crop year and 11 per cent over the ten-year average for the same period. Mill operations during April 1966 averaged 78.3 per cent of capacity when computed on a 25-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 169,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for March 1966 operated at 88.8 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 27 days.

Wheat milled for flour during April 1966 amounted to 7,443,000 bushels, 18 per cent below the 9,092,000 bushels milled in March 1966 but 1 per cent more than the 7,399,000 bushels milled in April a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 527,000 bushels compared with 528,000 bushels of this type for April 1965. Total wheat milled for flour during the August-April period of the current crop year amounted to 75,977,000 bushels 15 per cent greater than the 66,051,000 bushels milled in the same period of the preceding crop year. Millfeed production for April 1966 amounted to some 55,000 tons unchanged from the 55,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran, 23,000 (23,000) tons, shorts, 29,000 (28,000) tons and middlings, 3,000 (3,000) tons. Total millfeed production for the first nine months of the 1965-66 crop year amounted to 559,000 tons, 14 per cent over the 490,000 tons produced in the corresponding period of the previous crop year.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports for the month of April 1966 amounted to 1,541,000 hundredweight, 26 per cent greater than the 1,223,000 hundredweight exported during March 1966 but 12 per cent lower than the adjusted April 1965 exports of 1,760,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first nine months of the 1965-66 crop year amounted to 11,516,000 hundredweight, 13 per cent more than the 10,183,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) exported in the same period of the preceding crop year.
