GRAIN MILLING STATISTICS

The output of wheat flour in Canada for January 1968 amounted to 3,149,000 hundredweight representing an increase of 11 per cent over the December 1967 output of 2,842,000 hundredweight, but 3 per cent less than the January 1967 total of 3,235,000 hundredweight and 4 per cent below the tenyear (1958-67) average production for the month of January of 3,296,000 hundredweight. Ontario winter wheat flour included in the quantity for the month under review amounted to 245,000 hundredweight compared with 237,000 hundredweight in January 1967. Production of wheat flour during the first six months of the current crop year amounted to 19,061,000 hundredweight, 10 per cent lower than the 21,156,000 hundredweight produced during the same period of the 1966-67 crop year and 8 per cent below the ten-year average for the same period.

Mill operations during January 1968 averaged 78.6 per cent of capacity when computed on a 26-day working period in the month and a daily capacity of 154,000 hundredweight. Mills reporting for December 1967 operated at 73.5 per cent of their combined rated capacity for 25 days.

Wheat milled for flour in January 1968 amounted to 7,044,000 bushels, 11 per cent above the 6,371,000 bushels milled in December 1967, but 3 per cent less than the 7,266,000 bushels milled in January a year ago. Ontario winter wheat included in the current month's milled wheat amounted to 591,000 bushels compared with 573,000 bushels of this type for January 1967. Total wheat milled for flour during the August-January period of the current crop year amounted to 42,810,000 bushels, 11 per cent below the 47,841,000 bushels milled in the same period of the preceding crop year.

Millfeed production for January 1968 amounted to 53,000 tons, relatively unchanged from the 53,000 tons produced in the same month last year. The breakdown was as follows with last year's comparable figures in brackets: bran 18,000 (20,000) tons, shorts 32,000 (29,000) tons and middlings 3,000 (3,000) tons. The millfeed production for the first six months of the 1967-68 crop year amounted to 322,000 tons, 10 per cent less than the 357,000 tons produced in the corresponding period of the previous crop year.

According to preliminary Customs returns wheat flour exports for the month of December 1967 amounted to 942,000 hundredweight, 15 per cent greater than the 818,000 hundredweight exported during November 1967, but 44 per cent lower than the adjusted December 1966 exports of 1,691,000 hundredweight. Total shipments during the first five months of the 1967-68 crop year amounted to 4,561,000 hundredweight compared with the 6,429,000 hundredweight (adjusted to remove the effect of time lag in reporting returns) exported in the same period of the preceding crop year.

NOTE: The flour export figure for the month of January included in this report represents an unofficial estimate.
