

## SHIPMENTS OF PREPARED STOCK AND POULTRY FEEDS

The information presented in this report is arranged as follows:

### Table 1. Shipments of Stock and Poultry Feeds:

The estimated shipments of premixes and concentrates, complete and other feeds, as given in columns 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 are derived from analysis presented in Tables 2, 3, 4 and 5 following. The basis for this shipments detail is further explained in these respective sections. The purpose of Table 1 is to provide industry and other interested persons with anticipated trends in the manufactured Feeds field.

### Table 2. Shipments of Premixes and Concentrates:

These are the average shipments of premixes and concentrated feeds, by type and geographical destination, as reported monthly by primary manufacturers direct to the Bureau. They include premixes and concentrates moving into the hands of secondary or franchise operators (if any) as well as similar commodities moving direct to the farm level.

### Table 3. Estimated Feed Potential from Premixes and Concentrated Feeds:

The data in this table represents the total finished feed equivalent available from the volume of premixes and concentrated feeds reported by manufactures in Table 2. The estimate of potential feeds has been supplied by reporting establishments and eliminates the use of factors as previously employed by the Bureau. The resulting estimate should prove more useful since reported data will readily reflect the change in industry activity.

### Table 4. Shipments of Secondary or Complete Feeds:

The detail of feeds in this section represent the total secondary or finished feeds manufactured from raw ingredients (as opposed to those which use premixes or concentrates). This data is also reported directly by manufacturers of such products and is provided geographically by destination. The total volume of complete or finished feed is provided in Table 1, Section "B". However, provincial volumes may also be determined by the addition of volumes available in Table 2 and 3.

### Table 5. Shipments of Other Animal Feeds:

With the exception of scratch grain feeds and chopped ground or crushed grain feeds, all commodities are tabulated as reported by manufactures. Shipments of scratch grain feed and chopped ground or crushed grain feeds are collected from a sample group of manufacturers and these have been extended to represent total coverage.

### Table 6. Production, Shipments, Inventories and Imports of Dehydrated Alfalfa, Clover and Grass Meals:

The production and shipments recorded in this table are compiled from information received from operators of Dehydrated Alfalfa Meal plants in Canada, (see page 25 of this report for the list of contributors).

Imports are compiled by the External Trade Division from custom invoices and are the latest available.

SHIPMENTS OF PREPARED STOCK AND POULTRY FEEDS

CLASSIFICATION OF FEEDS

A complete feed is a formulated feed to be fed as is, and may be in the form of mash, pellets, crumbles, cubes, etc. For your assistance in classifying these commodities, the following explanation is offered:

1. Calf premixes and concentrates - Any premixes or concentrate for making a complete Calf Feed.
2. Dairy and Cattle premixes and concentrates - Any premixes or concentrate 24% protein or higher for Cattle or Dairy Cows.
3. Swine premixes and concentrates - Any premix or concentrate 35% protein or higher for swine.
4. Poultry premixes and concentrates:
  - Chick Starter Premixes and Concentrates - Any premix or concentrate for making a complete Chick Starter.
  - Broiler Premixes and Concentrates - Any premix or concentrate for making a complete Broiler Feed.
  - Laying and Hatching Premixes and Concentrates - Any premix or concentrate for making a complete feed for laying hens.
  - Fattening and Finishing Premixes and Concentrates - Any premix or concentrate for making a complete fattening feed for fowl other than Broilers or Turkeys.
  - Turkey Premixes and Concentrates - Any premix or concentrate for making a complete turkey feed.
  - Other Premixes and Concentrates - Any premix or concentrate for Poultry not covered by any other classification.
5. Calf feeds - Any complete feed for calves up to 5 months of age.
6. Dairy and Cattle Feeds - Any complete feed under 24% protein for Cattle or Dairy Cows but excluding Calf Feeds.
7. Swine Feeds - Any complete swine feed under 35% protein.
8. Poultry feeds:
  - Chick Starter Feeds - Any complete feed for starting chickens other than Broilers.
  - Broilers Feeds - Any complete feed for starting, growing or finishing Broilers.
  - Growing Feeds - Any complete feed for growing chickens.
  - Laying and Hatching Feeds - Any complete feed for laying hens.
  - Fattening and Finishing Feeds - Any complete feed for fattening cockerels, capons, or other fowl other than broilers and turkeys and excluding Scratch Grains.
  - Turkey Feeds - Any complete feed for starting, growing or finishing turkeys.
  - Other Complete Feeds - Any complete feed for pheasants, ducks or other poultry and not covered by any other classification.
11. Dog and cat foods:
  - Biscuits - Kibble and all baked products.
  - Meal - Pellets, cubes and other forms.
12. Scratch Grains - Any mixture of Whole or Cracked Grains only for Poultry.
13. Other Animal Feeds - Such as Horse Feed, Rabbit Feed, etc.


