SHIPMENTS OF PREPARED STOCK AND POULTRY FEEDS

JANUARY, 1948

In October, 1947, the Dominion Bureau of Statistics commenced a Monthly Survey of shipments in Canada of prepared stock and poultry feeds, showing provincial destinations, together with export shipments. The Survey was established on a sample basis, the coverage intended being about 80 per cent of the production reported to the Census of Industry for 1946 by manufacturers classified under the prepared stock and poultry feeds industry. The production relationship was adopted because no shipments data were available. The year 1946 was used because 1947 production figures will not be available for some considerable time.

It was originally proposed that the results of the Survey would be made available monthly, but difficulties encountered by many firms in adjusting their accounting systems to show the required provincial breakdowns, and other relevant problems, resulted in unavoidable delay in the preparation of figures for the early months. It is thought that the Survey is now well established, and, following the present release for the months of October, November and December, 1947, and for the month of January, 1948, figures will be released each month with a minimum of time lag.

It must be clearly understood that no reliable check data exists in connection with the provincial distribution of shipments and that there is no prior record of the seasonal variation in shipments of individual feeds. Also, the percentage coverage of the Survey, being established on a production basis, may not be valid in individual months, since the relationship of the shipments of the firms comprised in the sample, to the total shipments of all firms in the industry, may vary considerably from the annual production relationship. Therefore, the figures must be used with caution, and, indeed, should be considered chiefly as establishing a tentative check series for monthly movements in future years.

Table 1 shows the 1946 production of prepared stock and poultry feeds, taken from the annual Census of Industry reports, showing separately the production in the industry proper, the production outside the industry, and the production of the firms included in the current monthly shipments Survey, and is intended to be useful in indicating relationships in coverage. It will be noted that, although the general coverage approximates the original intention, coverage of certain individual items is low. The enlargement of the sample to cover all items more fully will be proceeded with from month to month until the situation is satisfactory.

In Tables 2 and 3 the compilation of the monthly shipments of the firms reporting in the sample is shown by months together with the average monthly production of the same firms in 1946. Some indication of the wide variation in seasonal movements may be found in these tables, as for example, in the case of starters and growing mashers where the average monthly production (1946) is many times greater than the monthly shipments reported in October, November and December, 1947, due, it would appear to the fact that the total annual production of these items finds its way to the market almost entirely during a few months of the year.

Tables 4 - 7 show the figures of only the firms reporting in the sample Monthly Shipments Survey, by feeds and by Provinces. It must be particularly stressed that these quantity figures are not total, and should be taken as indicating only approximate percentage Provincial distribution and trends.

Data are also collected on inventories and utilization of grains, and consideration will be given to publishing these at a later date.

SHIPMENTS OF PREPARED STOCK AND POULTRY FEEDS, JANUARY, 1948.

As will be observed from the grouping of items in the 1946 production column of the preceding table (table 2), the items available from the Annual Census of Industry production reports submitted by manufacturers differ in specification of items from those used in the Monthly Shipments Survey, i.e., poultry chick starter and turkey starter are shown separately on the Monthly Shipments Survey, whereas there is only a single general item for poultry starter, which would include turkey, on the Annual Production Schedule. The specification of items on the Annual Production Schedule can be ascertained from table 1, in which all figures are derived from that source. In table 2, the exact items of the Monthly Shipments Survey schedule are used, so that the summary of shipments by months will correspond exactly with the detailed data on shipments shown by months in tables 4-7. Because of this, only a single combined production figure for 1946 can be shown against the twelve shipments items for poultry and turkey feeds. In table 3, a supplementary comparison of 1946 production of poultry and turkey feeds, as against shipments, is given, the items on the latter being re-grouped to allow a greater number of comparisons.
