SHIPMENTS OF PREPARED STOCK AND POULTRY FEEDS
APRIL, 1948

In October, 1947, the Dominion Bureau of Statistics commenced a Monthly Survey of shipments in Canada of prepared stock and poultry feeds, showing provincial destinations, together with export shipments. The Survey was established on a sample basis, the coverage intended being about 80 per cent of the production reported to the Census of Industry for 1946 by manufacturers classified under the prepared stock and poultry feeds industry. The production relationship was adopted because no shipments data were available. The year 1946 was used because 1947 production figures will not be available for some considerable time.

It must be clearly understood that no reliable check data exists in connection with the provincial distribution of shipments and that there is no prior record of the seasonal variation in shipments of individual feeds. Also, the percentage coverage of the Survey, being established on a production basis, may not be valid in individual months, since the relationship of the shipments of the firms comprised in the sample, to the total shipments of all firms in the industry, may vary considerably from the annual production relationship. Therefore, the figures must be used with caution, and indeed, should be considered chiefly as establishing a tentative check series for monthly movements in the future years.

Table 1 shows the 1946 production of prepared stock and poultry feeds, taken from the annual Census of Industry reports, showing separately the production in the industry proper, the production outside the industry, and the production of the firms included in the current monthly shipments Survey, and is intended to be useful in indicating relationships in coverage. It will be noted that, although the general coverage approximates the original intention, coverage of certain individual items is low. The enlargement of the sample to cover all items more fully will be proceeded with from month to month until the situation is satisfactory.

Since it is not feasible to carry more than two months complete detail in each report, Tables 2 and 3 present summary material for all available months. Table 2 shows shipments, or sales, of each particular feed or concentrate reported by the firms in the sample, for the months of October, 1947 - April, 1948, without detail of provincial destination. Table 3 presents the shipments of related groups of feeds, or concentrates, by provincial destinations, for the months October, 1947 - April, 1948. It is hoped that these two tables give enough historical material for ordinary purposes, but in the event that complete detail is required prior to March, 1948, recourse can be had to the appropriate preceding reports.

Tables 4 and 5 show complete detail of feeds and concentrates shipped, by provincial destinations, for the months of March and April, 1948.

In using Tables 2 - 5, it must be particularly noted that the quantity figures given are not total, and should be taken only as indicating approximate trends.

Data are also collected on inventories and utilization of grains, and consideration will be given to publishing these at a later date.
