

SHIPMENTS OF PREPARED STOCK AND POULTRY FEEDS

NOVEMBER, 1950

In October, 1947, the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, in cooperation with the National Council of the Canadian Feed Manufacturers Association, commenced a Survey on a sample basis, of Shipments of Prepared Stock and Poultry Feeds, showing both Export shipments as well as Provincial destinations in Canada. The coverage of this Sample survey is approximately 80 per cent of the total 1948 production, reported by manufacturers classified under the Prepared Stock and Poultry Feeds Industry. In conjunction with this Shipments survey, figures were also collected on Inventories of Prepared Feeds at the end of each month, and the consumption of various grains used in making Prepared Feeds during each month.

It is in 1950 that this survey on Shipments commences to have real value, as there is a basis for comparing the current months with the corresponding months of the previous year. It will be several years, however, before sufficient monthly data is accumulated, with which to work out accurate seasonal trends in Provincial Shipments and Inventories.

Included in this publication are three diagrams which are intended to be of use and interest to all Feed manufacturers. Diagram one (page 2) shows separately the Shipments of Prepared Feeds and Concentrates in the year 1949 and to date for the year 1950. Diagram two (page 22) presents the Shipments of Prepared Stocks and Poultry Feeds and Concentrates in total for the year 1948, while diagram three (page 23) presents this same information to date for the years 1949-1950.

Table 1 presents the Total production of Prepared Stock and Poultry Feeds in Canada and also by Economic Areas for the year 1948.

Table 2 shows the 1948 production of Prepared Stock and Poultry Feeds showing separately the production in the industry proper, the production outside the industry, and the production of the firms included in the Monthly Shipments Survey, and is intended to be useful in indicating relationship in coverage.

Table 3 shows shipments or sales, of each particular feed or concentrate reported by the firms in the sample for the months, November, 1949 - November, 1950 without detail of provincial destination.

Table 4 presents the shipments of related groups of feeds or concentrates, by provincial destinations, for the months September, 1949 - November, 1950.

Table 5 and 6 show complete detail of feeds and concentrates shipped by provincial destinations for the months of November and October, 1950.


Table 7 shows the stocks of prepared stock and poultry feeds held by all firms reporting in the Monthly Sample Survey, by main groups of feeds and concentrates, for the months of November, 1949 - November, 1950.

Table 8 gives the consumption of grains used in making feeds during individual months, by all firms reporting in the Monthly Sample Survey for the months, September, 1949 - November, 1950.

Table 9 presents the stocks of milk, buttermilk and whey powder, held by all firms classified under the Prepared Stocks and Poultry Feeds Industry for the months September, 1949 - December, 1950.





SHIPMENTS OF PREPARED STOCK AND POULTRY FEEDS

Specifically for the use of our Agriculture Division, data are collected each month on the consumption of grains used in the manufacturing of prepared stock and poultry feeds, during individual months, from ALL firms reporting in the Monthly Sample Survey. It is thought that this information may be of use and interest to Feed Manufacturers, and figures on the consumption of these grains are given in Table 8, immediately below.

SHIPMENTS OF PREPARED STOCK AND POULTRY FEEDS

Supplementary to the Monthly Prepared Stock and Poultry Feeds Survey, and specifically for the use by the Department of Agriculture, data are collected each month on the stocks of milk powder, buttermilk powder and whey powder held by Feed Manufacturers. It is thought that the information may be useful to Feed Manufacturers also, and stocks of these items are given in Table 9, immediately following.

However, it must be stressed that the totals do not represent stocks held only by firms reporting in the Sample Monthly Survey of Shipments and Stocks of Prepared Stock and Poultry Feeds, although these particular firms account for a high percentage, but are approximately all **stocks** of milk powder, etc., held in the Prepared Stock and Poultry Feeds Industry as a whole.
