OILS AND FATS

MARCH 1966

The monthly Oils and Fats survey is a comprehensive commodity volume survey of production and inventories of all refined edible animal, marine and vegetable oils. Monthly production surveys of margarine, shortening, salad and cooking oils, lard and tallow and other oils have been conducted for several years but recent developments and increased consumer use of salad oils necessitated revisions to total coverage and more production detail for the use of industry and other statistical consumers. The necessary changes have been incorporated beginning with the January, 1966 issue. An explanation of the content of the various segments follows:

Table 1. Margarine and Margarine Oils: Includes the total production and inventory of packaged margarine and bulk margarine oils up to and including the last Friday of the respective calendar month. Bulk oils were not included in previous surveys. Any spread with an oil content not below 80 per cent should be reported as packaged margarine while bulk margarine oils will include the production of all finished deodorized oils whether produced for own use of for sale to other manufacturers or packagers. To assess movements out of processors' hands, data is separately provided relating to inventory held in immediate plant and in locations other than public cold storages. An additional geographical inventory area is provided which includes, as well as manufacturers' stocks, the volume held by cold storage warehouses and wholesalers.

Table 2. Shortening and Shortening Oils: Includes the total production and inventory of all packaged and finished deodorized bulk shortening oils whether produced for own use or for sale to other manufacturers or packagers. Coconut and palm kernel oils are included as shortening oils.

Table 3. Salad and Cooking Oils: Includes the total production of all finished deodorized liquid vegetable oils of all kinds except coconut and palm kernel in packages and bulk. Production includes all liquid oils whether originating from domestic or imported crude or semi-refined oils. Bottlers of finished processed formulae are not included.

Table 4. Lard: Includes production and inventory of lard rendered and processed. Lard rendered is the actual production of lard resulting from the rendering of fats, bones, etc. from hogs. Processed lard includes all further deodorized lard for sale to packers and customers whether used for further processing into shortening, margarine or as lard sales.

Table 5. Tallow: Includes the production and inventory respectively for edible and inedible types.

Table 6. Greases and Other Oils and Fats: Includes the production and inventory of greases and other oils and fats separately specifed.

Table 7. Crushings of Vegetable Oil Seeds: Includes the crushings of oil seeds by types, oil production by types and the resulting oil meal production by types. This data is provided for use in this bulletin by the Agriculture Division.

Table 8. Consumption of Oils and Fats: Includes the disappearance of refined edible animal, marine and vegetable oils into the manufacture of margarine and margarine oils, shortening and shortening oils and salad and cooking oils.

Data carried in this report reflect the experience of the respondent firms listed on pages 9 10 and 11 of the January issue. It is estimated that coverage is approximately 100%.

Catalogue 32-005 (Margarine Statistics) has been discontinued but preliminary detail on all the commodities in this report, will be released monthly in the Food and Beverages Services Bulletin.


