



#### June, 1953

All manufacturers of the main processed food items report their production quarterly, and the present release contains data, by quarters for the years 1951, 1952 and the first and second quarters of 1953.

Although exact agreement between the Quarterly and Annual Census of Industry data is not possible, coverage in both series is now correlated and the Quarterly may be considered as a useful indicator of production trends, available considerably in advance of the more detailed annual figures. To bring the historical Quarterly data into line the 1951 Quarterly series shown in the present report has been revised to agree in total with the Annual. Although 1952 annual totals are not yet available, the coverage in both series has in the past proven to be approximately the same and there should be no important revisions of the quarterly figures in the future.

The current publication provides information on the following items which are either finer breakdowns of items previously reported or items new to this' publication. Chocolate Confectionery in Bulk and Packages, Chocolates Boxed and Packaged, Chocolate Moulded Novelties, Infant and Junior Cereals, Fruits, Vegetables, Soups and Others. Pickles, Relishes, Chili Sauce, Prepared Candy and Icing Mixes, Prepared Cake Mixes, Prepared Mixes other, Syrups Beverage, Syrups Table, Weiners and Beans. In order to provide this added information it has been necessary to delete certain items from the publication. These items are Cream of Tartar, Eggs, Dried and Powdered, Carbonated Beverages, Devilled Ham and Chicken and Turkey Paste. The item Carbonated Beverages is still being published, in the Dominion Bureau of Statistics publication "The Daily Bulletin". Devilled ham and Chicken and Turkey Paste are now included with the Meat Paste Item.

On pages 14 and 15 of this report may be found a quarterly index of production for the first quarters of 1950, 1951, 1952 and 1953 the base period being the first quarter production of 1949. It is hoped that subscribers to this report will find this new section both desirable and useful.

On page 13 a table showing the provincial distribution of production in the first quarter of 1953 for the main items in each group may be found.

The last page of this report contains an alphabetical index of the items contained in the report and it is hoped that this index will provide the service it has been intended for in assisting users of this edition in locating specific items more readily, which they are interested in.

Changes in figures published in the March, 1953 publication have occured in the following items; Biscuits plain and fancy and Biscuits soda, 1952 and first quarter production for 1953, Chocolate bars, all quarters 1951, Jams total all quarters 1951, Salad Dressing and Sandwich Spreads 1952 and first quarter of 1953.






