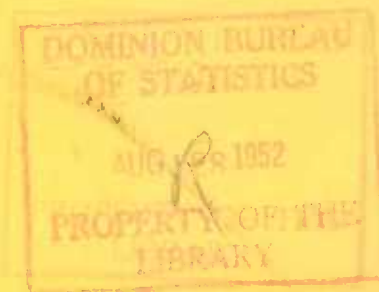

## QUARTERLY PRODUCTION OF PROCESSED FOODS

All manufacturers of the main processed food items report their production quarterly, and the present release contains data, by quarter for the years 1950 and 1951 and the first and second quarters of 1952.

Although exact agreement between the Quarterly and the Annual Census of Industry data is not possible, coverage in both series is now correlated, and the Quarterly may be considered as a useful indicator of production trends, available considerably in advance of the more detailed annual figures. To bring the historical quarterly data into line the 1950 Quarterly series shown in the present report has been revised to agree in total with the Annual. Although 1951 annual totals are not yet available, it is thought that coverage in both series was approximately the same and that the 1951 quarterly figures, as well as those for 1952, will not be subject to important revisions at a later date.

Due to many requests, we are now showing tables giving production by provinces, of some of the main items in each food group.

In the final tables of this release, production of major items is shown **in terms** of volume indexes (1935-1939=100). In addition, the individual index numbers have been weighted to arrive at volume indexes for the following groups of items: (a) Biscuits, Cocoa, Confectionery and Chocolate, (b) Other Canned Goods (c) Miscellaneous on the quarterly volume indexes.

This quarterly series does not include the pack of fresh fruits and vegetables, figures for which are collected at the end of each pack season and released separately.

Note: All 1951 and 1952 figures are preliminary subject to revision.
