

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#### March, 1954

All manufacturers of the main processed food items report their production quarterly, and the present release contains data, by quarters, for the years 1952, 1953, and the first quarter of 1954.

Although exact agreement between the Quarterly and Annual Census of Industry data is not available, coverage in both series is now correlated and the Quarterly may be considered as a useful indicator of production trends, available considerably in advance of the more detailed Annual figures. To bring the historical quarterly data into line the 1952 quarterly series shown in the present report has been revised to agree in total with the Annual. Figures for 1953 and the first quarter of 1954 are preliminary and are subject to revision.

The present publication has provided for the first time a further breakdown of certain commodities. These changes were brought about in response to many requests for further details. Chocolate bars, 10 cents, have been divided into two sections - solid and coated. Prepared mixes, other, have been divided into prepared pie mixes and prepared mixes, other (including doughnuts, cookies, etc.). The quick-frozen fruits and vegetables shown in this publication in the past have been deleted and this information in the future will be found in the special compilation series for Packs of Fruits and Vegetables. This will give information on each individual pack rather than in totals as shown in this publication in the past.

In order to provide comparison for some of the major items, subscribers are referred to pages 15 and 16 wherein will be found indexes of first quarter production based on the first quarter of 1949=100. It is felt that this total, which was instituted in the March 1953 issue, will be of considerable help and interest to subscribers. Each quarterly publication carries the quarterly indexes for the quarter which is, at that time, being published and, therefore, by referring to a year's supply, records of production indexes can be obtained for all quarters from 1949 to date. The present report carries all revisions which have been made to date and all figures up to and including 1952 are final and only the 1953 and 1954 indexes are subject to revision.

The table on provincial distribution of production, which was carried in this publication in the past, has been deleted as it was found that in many cases, in order not to reveal individual firms' activities, provincial distribution had to be grouped in one or two provinces and in many cases no information could be shown at all.

The last page of the report contains an alphabetical index of all the items contained herein and should provide ready reference in locating items as desired.
