STOCKS OF DAIRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS, AUGUST 1, 1938.

CREAMERY BUTTER. The grand total of Canadian creamery butter on hand in Canada at the opening of business on August 1, 1938, amounted to 50,078,942 lb., consisting of 49,243,321 lb. actually reported and 835,621 lb. estimated for firms that failed to report. Of the grand total 33,409,022 lb. were held in cold storage warehouses and 16,669,920 lb. in dairy factories.

The Grand Total stocks are 23.3 per cent more than last year. The net "Into-Storage" movement for the month of July 1938 was 17.3 million 1b. as compared with a similar movement of 14.1 million 1b. for July 1937. These stocks are the largest every recorded for August 1.

In addition to the above, however, it is to be noted that approximately 162,000 lb. of Bonded and Imported butter were on hand on August 1, 1938.

Carloads of butter in transit by rail and at railway terminals reported by the railway companies, amounted to 476,000 lb.

DAIRY BUTTER. The stocks of this commodity as reported at August 1, 1938 amounted to 354,682 lb., which is a decrease of 16.3 per cent from last year.

Warehouses and dairy factories reported 37,275,160 lb. of cheese. Adding 1,103,743 lb. as the estimate for outstanding firms, a grand total of 38,378,903 lb. is shown. Firms added to our list, as of January 1, 1938, contributed approximately 1.3 million 1b.

These figures represent an increase of 2.9 million 1b. over last year and a net "Into-Storage" movement of 6.3 million 1b., which is 1.4 million 1b. more than the same movement for July 1937.

CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTS. Whole Milk products amounted to 24,012,806 lb. of which Evaporated Whole Milk was 21,285,043 1b.

By-Products totalled 6,389,373 lb. Included in this amount are 4,394,559 lb. of Skim Milk Powder.

EGGS. Cold Storage eggs amounted to a total of 8,632,771 dozens.

Fresh eggs are reported to a total of 571,392 dozens.

Total Shell eggs show a net "Into-Storage" movement of 348 thousand dozens during the month as compared with an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 172 thousand dozens a year ago.

Shell eggs in transit at August 1, 1938, amounted to 176,760 dozens.

Frozen eggs amounted to 4,960,166 lb., the net "Into-Storage" movement being 471 thousand 1b. as compared with 248 thousand 1b. last year.

DRESSED POULTRY. Chickens in stock amounted to 728,953 lb., fowl to 231,814 lb., and turkeys to 1,844,411 lb. Total stocks of all poultry amounted to 3,214,956 lb.

The net "Out-of-Storage" movement is 298 thousand 1b. as compared with 840 thousand 1b. in July 1937.

Poultry in transit amounted to 50,000 lb.
