

SOURCE AND CONTENT

Data for this report are collected by mail questionnaires from dairy factories, concentrated milk manufacturers, public and semi public cold storages, meat packers, wholesale grocers' warehouses and central warehouses of chain grocery stores.

Inventories are taken at manufacturers and wholesale level and firms are required to report all stocks held in their own establishments or in specially rented rooms elsewhere as at the opening of the first business day of the month.

Stocks of butter and cheese in dairy factories are obtained with the co-operation of the provincial governments.

STOCKS OF DAIRY and POULTRY PRODUCTS

December 1, 1960

CREAMERY BUTTER:

At the opening of business on December 1, 1960, the stocks of creamery butter on hand in Canada amounted to 125,630,000 lb. Cold Storage Warehouses had in store 95,617,000 lb. while dairy factories held 29,978,000 lb. The summary total was higher than last year by 9.5 million pounds. The five year average 1955-59 of December 1 stocks is 104,581,000 lb. The November 1960 "out-of-storage" movement was 9.2 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 16.1 million pounds last year.

CHEDDAR CHEESE:

The total stocks of Canadian cheddar cheese were 57,926,000 lb. There were no stocks of imported cheddar cheese on hand on December 1, 1960. The summary total was higher than last year by 4.5 million pounds and showed an "out-of-storage" movement of 3.8 million pounds for November 1960.

CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTS:

Stocks of evaporated whole milk held by or for manufacturers amounted to 53,084,000 lb. which was a decrease of 1.9 million pounds from last year. The "out-of-storage" movement of evaporated whole milk for November 1960 was 8.6 million pounds. Stocks of the chief by-products, skim-milk powder, amounted to 24,546,000 lb., an increase of 2.8 million pounds over last year and a decrease of 2.3 million pounds from last month.

EGGS:

The December 1, 1960 report shows 3,000 cases of cold storage eggs and 43,000 cases of fresh eggs. There were no shell eggs in transit. Frozen eggs totalled 6,998,000 lb. being 1.4 million pounds higher than the 1959 figures. The "out-of-storage" movement for November 1960 was 1.1 million pounds as compared with a similar movement of 2.4 million pounds during November 1959.

POULTRY MEAT:

The summary total of Dressed and Eviscerated poultry meat stocks of December 1, 1960 was higher than last year by 1.6 million pounds. An "into-storage" movement of 12.8 million pounds is shown for the month of November 1960. By kinds, the dressed and eviscerated quantities in stock, the latter in brackets, were: Chicken 1,236,000 lb. (5,966,000) lb., Fowl 3,450,000 lb. (4,685,000) lb. and turkey 1,716,000 lb. (28,635,000) lb. These figures do not include estimates for firms whose reports were not received on time. There were 300,000 lb. of poultry meat in transit on December 1, 1960.
